18. COLLEGE LIBRARY

Library and information centre of St. Thomas College of Teacher Education satisfies the teaching and research needs of the college. The library has been functioning since the establishment of this college. The library collection includes 16,140 books both for general and reference, purposes around 87 journals and periodicals, 31,35,00,0 e-books, 6000 e-journals through N-LIST programme, 355 bound volumes of periodicals, 720 theses, 305 cds and 6 newspapers. Our reference collection consists of 1200 books including educational encyclopaedias, like International Encyclopaedia of Education, International Encyclopaedia of Educational Technology, International Encyclopaedia of Educational Research, etc. The Library is automated using software “Campus NET”. Free internet access is allowed to students and faculty of the college. The College is a member of INFLIBNET-NLIST programme under information and Library Network Centre (an autonomous inter University Centre of UGC). Our library portal is www.infoweavers.in/stcteplibrary.

Digital Library - The college has set up “Campus NET Digital Library for archiving the research collections of our students and faculty. Access to digital library is restricted to teachers and students by giving unique usernames and passwords. Our digital library has 5 major categories such as e-documents, teacher’s collections, multi-media collections, college library and CD collections.
