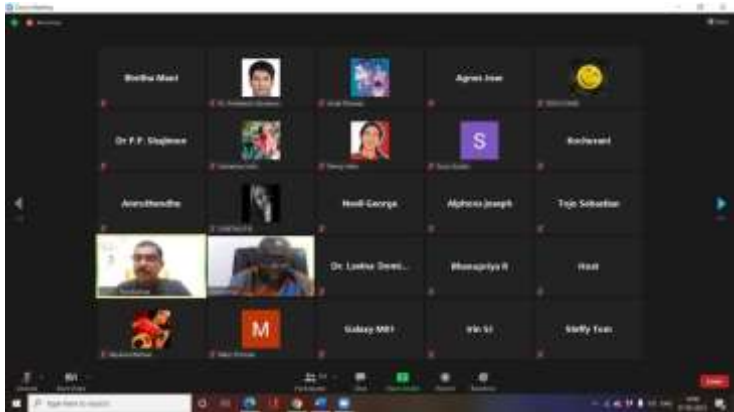

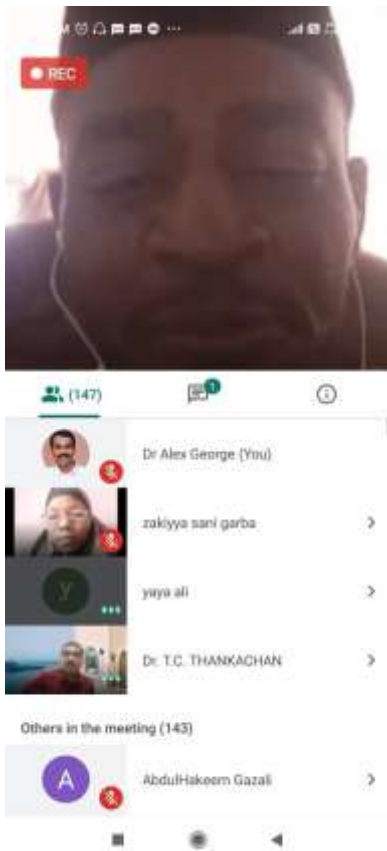

Loving touch to rejuvenate the buds...

What is it?
Sparsham is the timely intervention of a specially trained team of 125 Educationalists, which aims to rejuvenate the children during COVID times and post COVID life. The programme aims to lighten up social life by transcending the barrier imposed by social distancing through interaction enabled by modern information technology.

For whom?
The students of standard 3- XII, their parents and local gardeners get an opportunity to interact with the team members. Authentic response will be provided to doubts related to the student's focus on studies, identification of learning difficulties, personality development, time management, ways to organize stress, media literacy, etc.

Through whom?
A team of 125 well trained, certified teachers and teacher trainees interact in the first phase. They are organized into twenty teams with team leaders and mentors to respond to each query.

How to utilize Sparsham?
Children, in the presence of parents, or with no parents and family members, directly, can contact the team using any of the contact numbers provided from 8 A.M to 8 P.M. Based on preliminary assessment of the issues involved, a suitable counsellor will be allotted to each case. It could be convenient if discussion points are noted down beforehand to use time during the interaction.

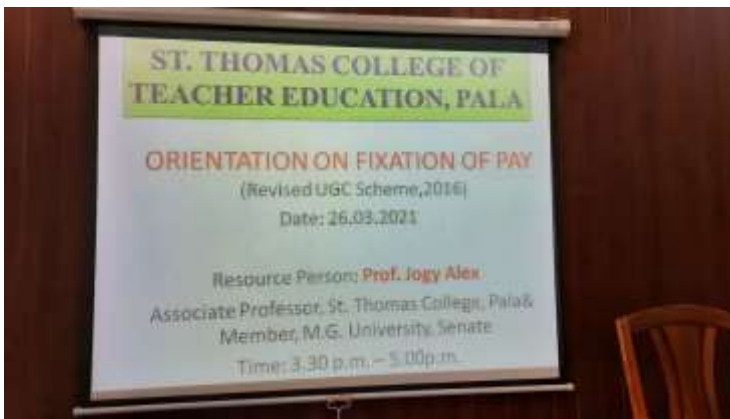
