

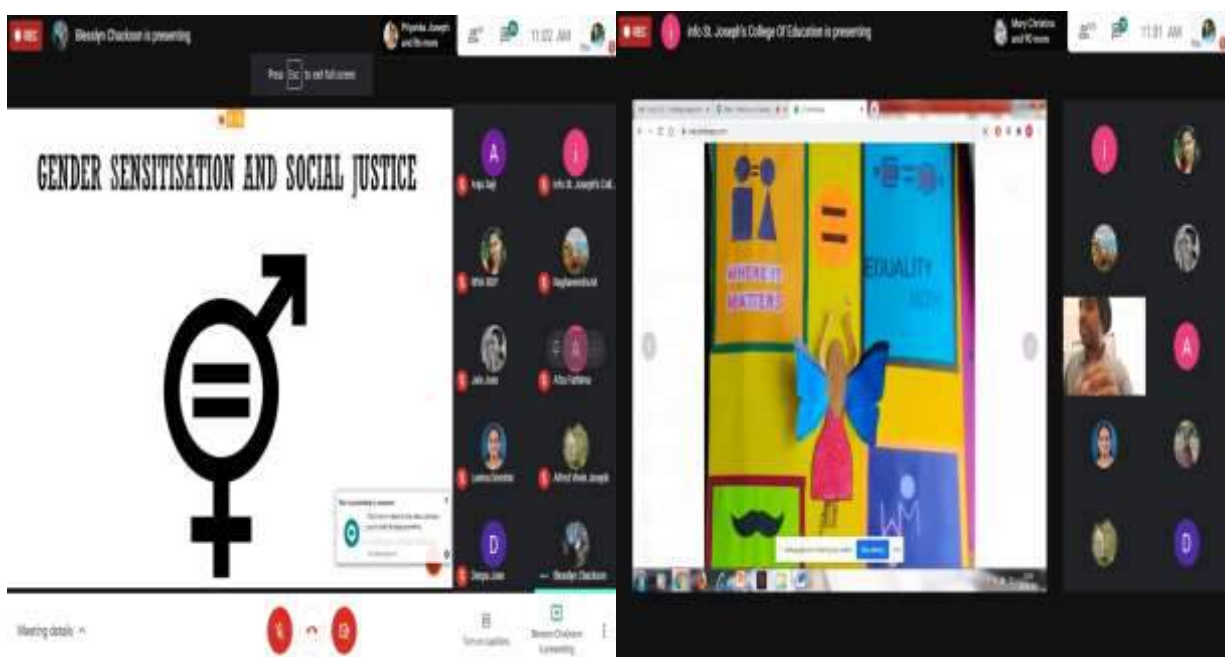

26 June 2020 - MoU with St. Joseph's College of Education, Mysuru, Karnataka

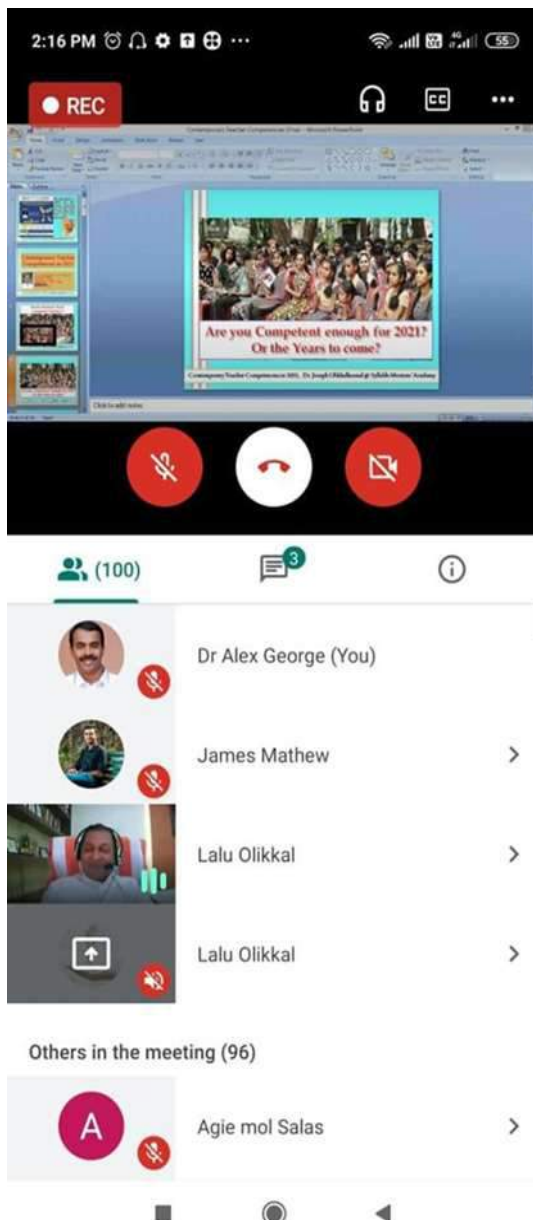

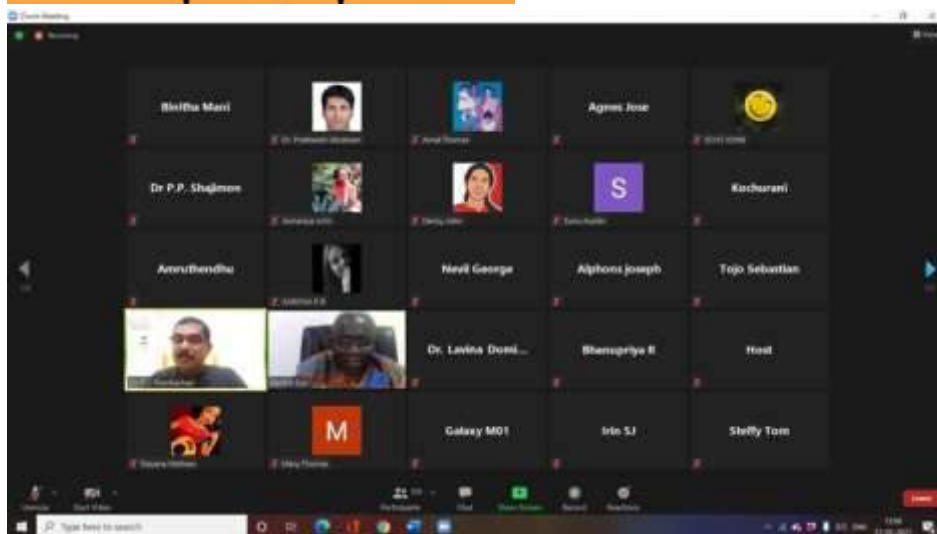


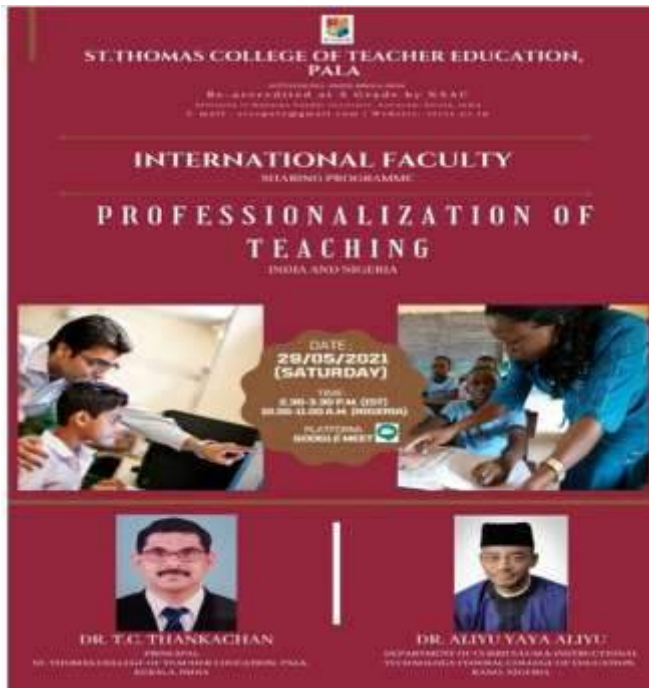
Faculty sharing programmes at international level (online mode)
