Activity 3

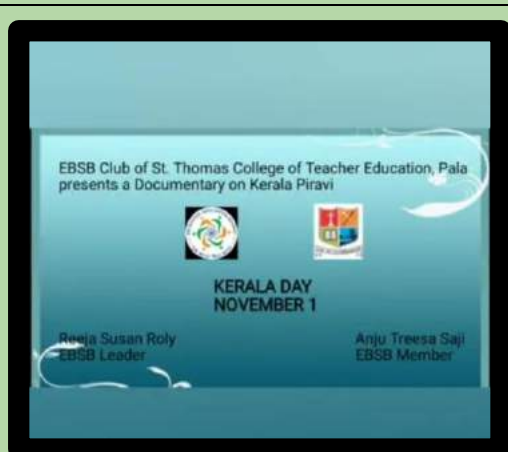

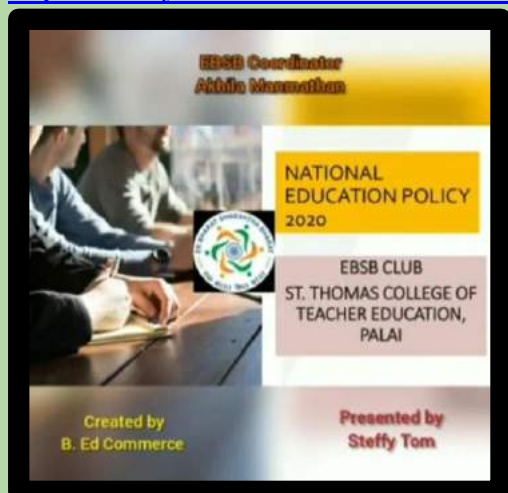

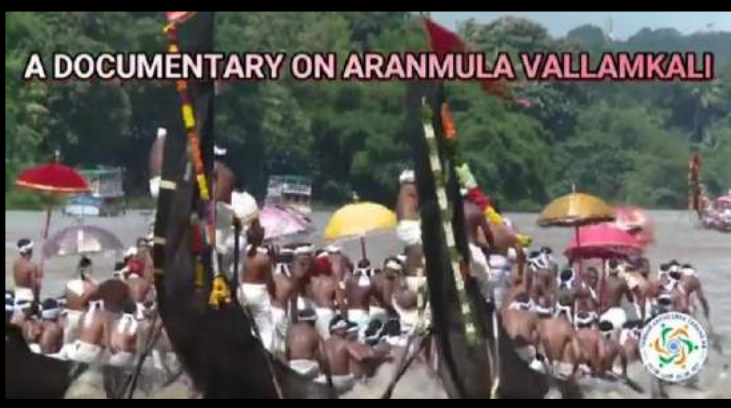
