Scope

The scope of possible collaboration on academic covered by in this Letter of Intent includes the following categories:


- Explore on offering programme(s) on franchise and/or twinning basis;

This Letter of Intent is effective from 6th April 2019 as the date of execution by the appropriate officer of each signatory institution. The letter of Intent covers a period of three (3) years from the final date of signing, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving a notice of at least six (6) months-notice to the other party in writing.

This Letter of Intent is not intended to be legally binding and may be replaced by a formal Memorandum of Understanding when agreed to by both parties.
