Good Morning everyone. The Guest of Honour Rev. Fr. Mathew Chandrankunnel, Managing Director, Rashtra Deepika Ltd., former Principals and staff, members of the faculty, Alumni, parents, guests and my dear students. It gives me great pleasure to welcome you all to the 62nd Annual Day and farewell meeting 2018-19 of St. Thomas College of Teacher Education, Pala and to present the Annual Report of the college for the current academic year.

Commencement of Courses

The academic year commenced on 4th June, 2018 for M.Ed., B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. courses. The two year M.Ed. and B.Ed. programmes, 2018-20 batch, commenced on 2nd July, 2018. The present student strength is 219; the two year B.Ed. batches comprise 97 students, the M.Ed. batches comprise 18 students and the D.El.Ed. has 95 students on the roll. The selection of students was purely on merit basis and in accordance with the guidelines of the Government of Kerala and Mahatma Gandhi University.

The annual consecration of the institution and inauguration of the M.Ed., B.Ed. and D.El.Ed., courses 2018-20 were done by Mar Jacob Muricken, the Auxiliary Bishop of Pala and Manager of the college on 5th September, 2018. On the same day teachers' day was celebrated and Mar Jacob Muricken delivered the teachers' day message.

Results

The University Examination Results for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. 2016-18 batch students were admirably good. Out of the 50 students who appeared for the B.Ed. examinations, 13 students secured A+ grade, 30 secured A grade and 7 passed with B grade. Out of the nine students who appeared for the M.Ed. examination, eight students secured B grade and one passed with C grade. The pass percentage for D.El.Ed. students is 75.

Details of the Staff

The strength of members of the faculty for B.Ed, M.Ed and D.El.Ed. sections is 22.

The D.El.Ed. faculty Sri. Bibish John resigned the post to take up the appointment as UPSA and Smt. Deepa A.K. was appointed in his place. Smt. Jainamma C Chiramattel and Rev. Sr. Saly V.C. took leave for three months and Smt. Christy John and Smt. Sheeja Thomas were appointed during the period. Our non teaching staff Sri M.J. Joseph retired on 31st January, 2019 after 30 years of selfless, service. Our

teaching staff Dr. Sr. Shalby P. Jose will retire on 31st May, 2019 after a devoted service of 13 years in the college. May I take this opportunity to extend heartfelt gratitude for the valuable, memorable and meritorious service rendered to the college.

The career and placement Cell

The college career and placement cell provides training for the student teachers to clear the teacher eligibility tests, state eligibility test and national eligibility test under the guidance of the teaching staff of this college. Out of the 48 second year B.Ed students, 32 have already cleared NET, SET and TET exams. All the students of the college who completed their teacher education course in the year 2018 were appointed as teachers in various colleges and schools both inside and outside Kerala. Under the auspices of the placement cell of our college, campus interviews were held by reputed schools inside and outside Kerala to recruit teachers. Extension Activities

Our teachers are provided Counselling services free of cost to school children and parents. We try to evoke social sensitivity among student teacher's through Extension and outreach activities. They regularly visit Maria Sadanam and contribute meals and financial help to the inmates. Many of them have participated in flood relief activities at various places. They cleaned the roads of the Pala Municipality and collected plastic waste on Oct. 2nd 2018, the Gandhijayanthi day. They cleaned the tourist place Vagamon and collected plastic waste. The library for Rural mothers at the government aided L.P. school, Meenachil, Continuing Education Centre at Meenachil etc., are other areas of our extension activities.
