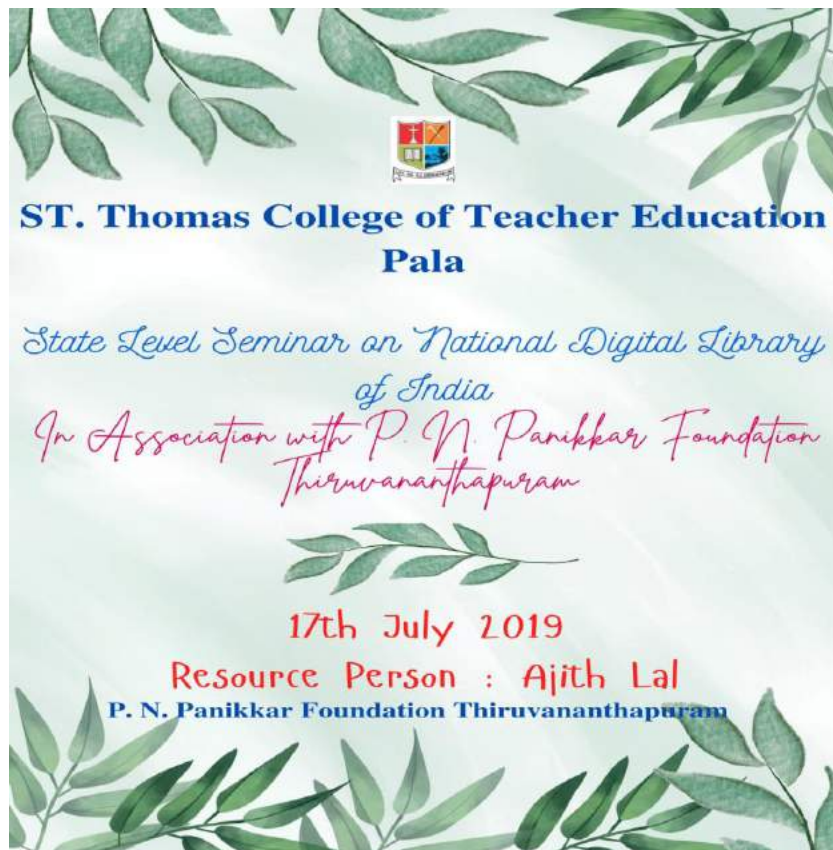


Reading Club Activities


2019-20

PROGRAMMES

1. "REVIEW A BOOK"

This programme is organised to inculcate the reading habit among student teachers and enhance thinking, analysing, and summarizing capacities of students. It is an opportunity for students to choose a book they have read recently or their favourite book and write a review. The book can be based on any topic of student interest and entries can either be in Malayalam or in English. Original and Creative work produced by students will be compiled and made available in the library. The review should include:

- Title and author of the book
- Short summary of the book
- Students' feelings about the book - what was good or bad, interesting, can focus on characters, etc.
- Suggestions like who might be interested in reading this book.
- Whether the student would recommend reading this book or not.
- Entries may include pictures and must be clear.

The 'Book Review' may be sent as a pdf file to the email id given at the end.

2. "BOOK TALK: BOOK DISCUSSION PODCASTS"

This programme aims to inculcate an appreciation for books, to persuade others to read the book and to foster a strong reading culture among students. Analytical reading habit being one of the most important prerequisites for a successful teaching career would be evident at its best in the Book Talk Podcasts. Below are some guidelines that students should consider when preparing for their book talk.

- Time limit: 5 to 10 minutes
- Do your own thing...create your own individual style.
- Begin your presentation in a creative way about title, author, publication etc.
- What made you choose this book? Share the reasons behind your choice....

IF THE BOOK IS FICTION:

- Tell the title and author of your book
- Bring out the ethos and cultural background of the work
- Who is/are the main character(s)? What is his or her problem or challenge?
- What is the theme of the book?
- Summarize the plot line.
- DON'T tell the ending! Try to convince others that this is a book they want to read!

IF THE BOOK IS NONFICTION:

- Tell the title and author of your book
- Briefly summarize the book.
- Tell at least 3 things you learned by reading this book.
- Give 2 reasons why you think someone might read this book.

Create a podcast of your 'Book Talk' using Anchor App and send the link to the email id given at the end.

3. "BOOK POSTER"

An Online Book Poster Exhibition
Create a unique poster that represents a novel or story of your own choice in an original way. The poster must include the title of the work and the name of the author. The work can incorporate any medium of art including drawings, paintings, photographs, etc. Please submit entries in JPEG format.
