Both parties believe that the close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 3.2. **Skill Development Programs:** The First Party will give training to the staff as well the students of the second Party when help is sought by the First Party and vice versa for their skill, academic and professional development.
- 3.3. **Faculty Development Programs:** The Second Party to train the Faculties of the First Party for the improvement of the First Party considering the National building up standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 3.4. **Both Parties** to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programme on the terms specified as per the need of the time.
- 3.5. **There is no financial commitment** from the either parties as per the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 4: TERMINATION OF THE MoU

- 4.1. **This Agreement** will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed term.
- 4.2. **Bother parties** may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.
