The speech training program empowers participants to become confident and effective speakers. Through targeted exercises, practical sessions, and expert feedback, attendees will improve their public speaking skills, including clarity, pacing, and voice modulation.

FLUENT VOICES

A speech training programme was conducted at the college auditorium on 7 th June 2024 under the activity milieu of Oratory Club of St.Thomas College of Teacher Education Pala in collaboration with NSS unit of the college. The event started with a session by Dr.Alex George, NSS programme officer, which marked its initiation by the distribution of a book written by Fr. Thomas Moolayil on the strategies to be followed to articulate an effective speech. Then an interactive session was led among students where the students were arranged in groups of two. They faced each other and each one talked for three minutes on various topics like 'School Life', 'What would you do if you become the Prime Minister of India?', 'Tapioka Farming' and 'Our College'. Dr.T. C. Thankachan, Teacher In-Charge of Oratory Club gave guidelines after each speech session and the event was evaluated by him at the end. Students also figured out that the workshop helped to boost their communicative abilities.
