


ST. THOMAS COLLEGE OF TEACHER EDUCATION, PALA









Sparsham Phase II aims at the overall well-being of the students of St. Thomas HSS Pala (the adopted school) of St. Thomas College of Teacher Education Pala (STCTE). These can be then done through academic help, financial support and the concept of sharing for a better tomorrow.

The materialistic and non- materialistic aspects of the school is thus given priority and then the teacher trainees along with the teaching and non- teaching faculty of the college supports this aim. The NSS Unit of the College plays a lead role in the same. These activities are coordinated by

As part of Sparsham Phase II programme, the teacher trainers from St. Thomas College of Teacher Education Pala (STCTE) started special tuition for the students at St.Thomas HSS Pala. The major aim of the initiative is to foster language language learning, English, Malayalam and Hindi of the students. For this students were given classes on all working days from 9.00 am to 9.45 am under the guidance of teacher trainees: Aileen Mariya Kuriakose, Issac Cherian Kattakayam and Ajay Jijo who were there for their school internship. 
9. Reading Day
