EXCELLENCE IN ACADEMICS, STUDENT SUCCESS CURRICULAR AND CO-CURRICULAR

- The college secured cent percent pass for B.Ed. students at the university exam; including university ranks (4 first ranks, 1 third rank, 4 sixth ranks, 3 eighth ranks, 2 ninth ranks and 2 tenth ranks in various optional subjects at B.Ed. level). The M.Ed. final year students also graduated with a cent percent pass and four ranks (third, fourth, eighth and ninth positions).
- The college hosted a two day national seminar on 'Futuristic Appositeness of Contemporary Research and NEP 2020'.
- Seven students won prizes at inter-collegiate arts and sports competitions.
- The college was selected for the third time in a row for the best innovative idea at the District Level Evaluation of the Young Innovators Programme (YIP)2023, organised by the Kerala Development and Innovation Strategic Council(K-DISC).
