
INSTITUTIONAL DISTINCTIVENESS






Figure 3: Constructed foundation with the actual plan pointed




Figure 2: NSS Volunteers involved in the activity of filling of concrete in the foundation






Figure 3: Constructed foundation with the actual plan pointed
