Programme: Orientation on Revised M.Ed. Curriculum

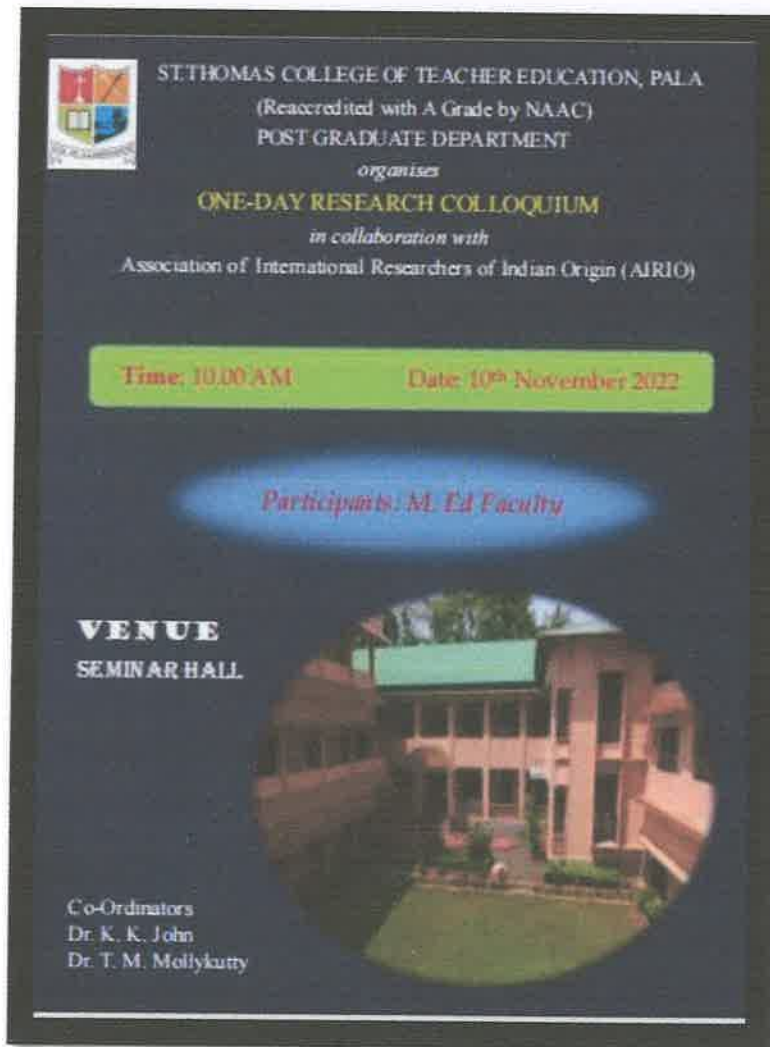
