

## ACADEMIC ADVICE GUIDANCE

## Principal's Declaration

Students are encouraged to undertake self-study courses by way of

- 1. Orientation to the significance of self-study courses and familiarizing students with different platforms providing self-study courses during the Bridge course.
- 2. Inform students of the commencement of courses.
- 3. Encouraging students to register for at least one online course and providing computer and internet facilities to register.
- 4. Mentoring and Academic counselling are provided in the institution.
- 5. Two hours per week set for self-study courses, including mentoring and counselling.
- 6. Faculties are assigned to be mentored.
- 7. A mentoring dairy is maintained.
- 8. During the last five years, 460 students have completed the self-study courses
- 9. Students are advised to enrol in self-study courses, and SWAYAM and MOOC are introduced to them.
- 10 Make a seminar hall, classrooms, projector, and Internet facilities available to attend online classes and group interactions.

11. We provide permission to attend examinations and other training programs to complete the courses.
