2.4.2 Report on the activities that students go through as a preparatory to school- based practice teaching and internship


1. Formulating learning objectives

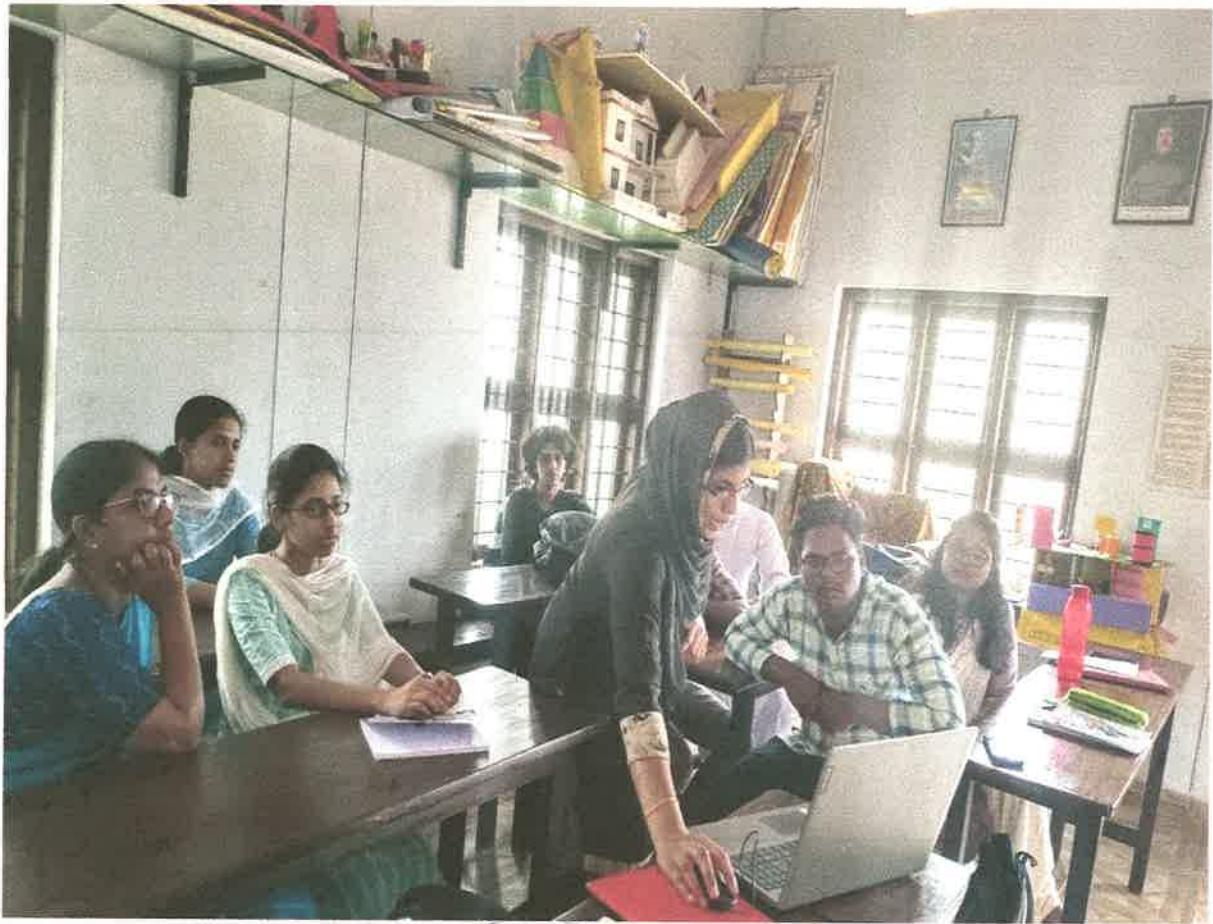
Students learn to formulate learning objectives in different phases. They learn the theory of taxonomy of educational objectives in the first semester, Bloom's taxonomy of educational objectives in the pedagogy courses of their respective options. They learn to frame educational objectives for each domain. Besides the objectives in the pedagogy courses, they learn to frame appropriate objectives for Physical Education classes, yoga classes, value education lesson plans, the learning resources prepared by them.


During the second semester students learn to prepare objectives in different stages:

1. Discussion lessons – The students work in groups. They discuss and write lesson plans under the guidance of the teacher educator.
2. Demonstration classes – Student teachers observe the classes with school students by experts or experienced teachers
3. Criticism classes – Student teachers write lesson plans and take classes based on the lesson plans with school students or in simulated mode (peers as students in the college).
4. Induction programme – Students write lesson plans with definite objectives and take five classes in their respective subjects during the induction programme

2. Content mapping

Students do detail content analysis of the textbooks of standard 8, 9 and 10 of their concerned subject.




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3. Lesson planning/ individualized education plans (IEP)

Student teachers learn to write lesson plans in different phases. Students are taught to plan lessons bearing in mind the individual needs of the children—learning style, cognitive style.

Students are given ample opportunities for community engagement with the local community.

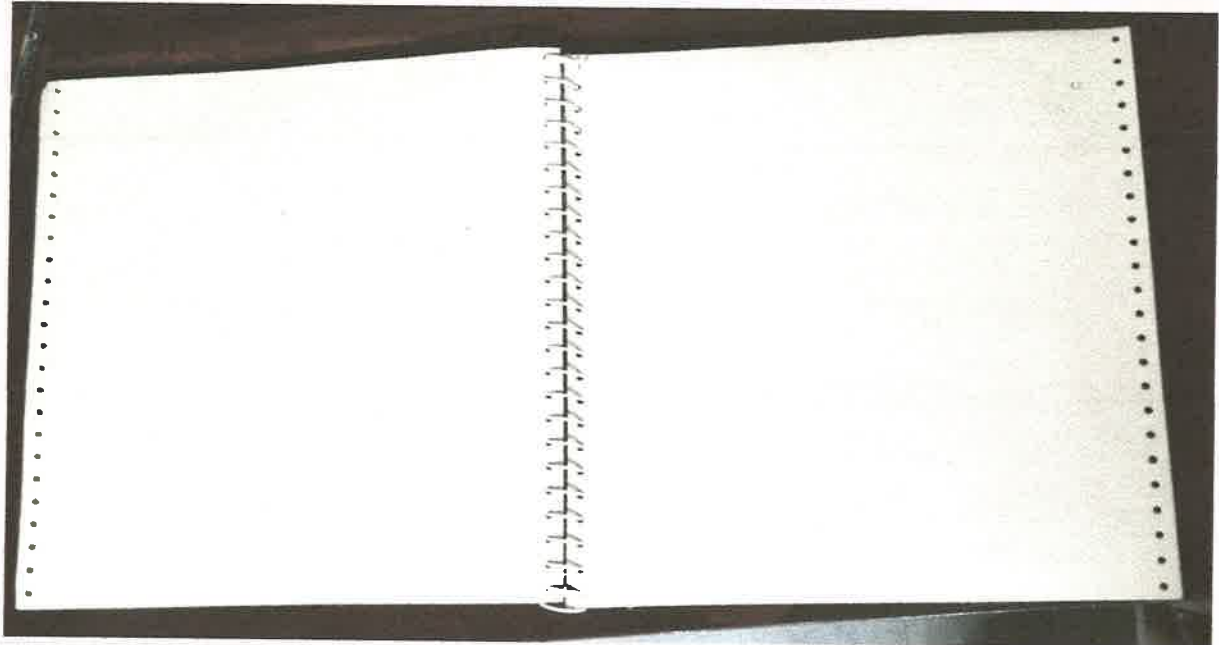
