
2. Nirakkoott Day 2 – Painting the walls of St. Thomas HSS Pala





4. Nirakkoott Day 4- Painting the walls of Aided LPS Meenachil








8. Nirakkoott Day 8- Painting the walls of St.Thomas HSS Pala








11. Nirakkoott Day 11- Painting the walls of St. Mathews UPS Elikulam








45.SET NET COACHING
