
## 1) LOCAL TOWN CLEANING

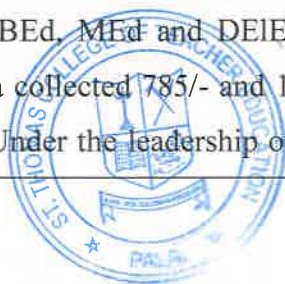

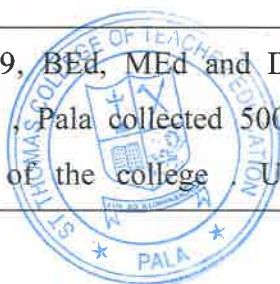


