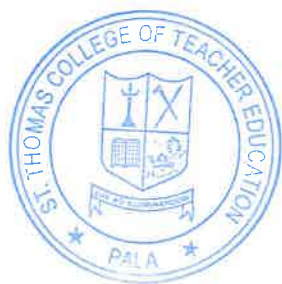

SANNADHAM 2019-20

The floods, cyclones and health emergencies including Nipah and covid 19 pandemic have necessitated community based volunteering to strengthen our social cohesion. Moved by the immense response of the civil society, the Government has decided to form the Directorate of Samookhika Sannadhasena also called community volunteer corps.

As part of this program, ST. THOMAS COLLEGE OF TEACHER EDUCATION, PALA fully cooperate with the steps initiated by the state by enlisting teacher trainees for volunteering by registering on SANNADHAM portal.
