#### 1. OBJECTIVE:



#### 3. FUNDING:

- d) Expenses for transportation, room and board and personal expenses of exchange students, teachers or officers shall be covered by each individual. Students will pay their registration, courses or professional practices at their home university, so that they can be recognized afterwards.

- g) Students, professors and officers must acquire a medical insurance policy. The universities may offer them advice in seeking appropriate insurance.

## 4. NO EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP:

h) The parties agree that this Agreement shall not be construed in any manner as establishing any kind of partnership or bond of a labor nature between them. Thus, in all activities stemming from the present MoU and from subsequent specific action plans, the parties are in the understanding that, in all cases, employment relationships shall remain in force between the employing institution and its respective personnel.

#### 5. CREDITS /ACCREDITATION:

i) Credits and grades shall be awarded in accordance with the academic achievement

- The institutions shall act as facilitators, but they will have no obligation whatsoever in terms of the actions, behaviors or financial aspects of the students / participants involved in the exchange.
- rm) The students/participants shall enjoy the same rights and privileges as regular students/faculty, and shall observe the norms and rules of the Host University/Instaution and in the host country. Any violate on of the laws of the receiving country and / or the rules of the Host University/Institution by an exchange participant shall be grounds for the immediate termination of the privileges in the context of this Agreement.
- n) The host institution agrees to assist to provide boarding, lodging and necessities and to provide work space, library and laboratory facilities as appropriate.

#### 7. AUTONOMY:

o) This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.


#### 8. TERM:

- 2. Sharing of reference servicereciprocally
- 3. Jointly organize seminars/webinars, conferences, orworkshops,
- 4. Participating in seminars/webinars and similar academicdiscussions
- 5. Extension of the use of library facility to students, and faculty members
- reciprocally with specific prior sanction of the principal of the college concerned
- 6. Offering research consultancy service
- 7. Offering inter institutional certificate courses
- 8. Extend support in research conducted by faculty and students of both collegesincluding assistance in plagiarism checking
- 9. Mutual support in the purchase of books and resources
- 10. Organising training for librarians, faculty members and students

Nothing in this Memorandum is intended to or shall be deemed to establish any partnership or joint venture between the parties or constitute any activities that either party would otherwise be able to undertake.

The details for the efficacious implementation of the memorandum of understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies. rules and regulations of both the institutions.

There is no financial commitment on the part of Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous) and St. Thomas College of Teacher Education, Pala to take-up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

#### 3. PERIOD

This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of its signature and seal and may be terminated by either side by giving six months' notice to that affect in writing.
