4. NO EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP:

The first party and the second party are hereafter jointly referred to as parties and individually as party)

WHEREAS:

The parties which are institutions imparting and offering educational courses herein after have intended agreed and consented in the following terms and deeds in pursuance of a common intent to promote and strengthen the integral development of their students and research scholars which are specifically explained the objectives and field of co-operation as:

1. Inter library loan transactions; which includes exchange of academic materials, (articles, books chapters) and publications on reciprocal basis under the provisions of this MoU.
2. Sharing of reference service reciprocally
3. Jointly organize seminars/webinars, conferences, or workshops.
4. Participating in seminars/webinars and similar academic discussions
5. Extension of the use of library facility to students, and faculty members reciprocally with specific prior sanction of the principal of the college concerned
6. Offering research consultancy service
7. Offering inter institutional certificate courses
8. Extend support in research conducted by faculty and students of both colleges- including assistance in plagiarism checking
9. Mutual support in the purchase of books and resources
10. Organising training for librarians, faculty members and students

Both the parties have agreed to develop the above collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity. The objectives stated above define the framework for the cooperation of the parties in the following sections.

2. SCOPE OF MOU

Nothing in this Memorandum is intended to or shall be deemed to establish an exclusive relationship between the parties or to restrict any activities that either party would otherwise be able to undertake. Nothing in this Memorandum is intended to or shall be deemed to establish any partnership or joint venture between the parties or constitute any activities that either party would otherwise be able to undertake.

The details for the efficacious implementation of the memorandum of understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.

There is no financial commitment on the part of Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous) and St. Thomas College of Teacher Education, Pala to take-up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

3. PERIOD

This MoU shall remain in force for a period of five years from the date of its signature and seal and may be terminated by either side by giving six months' notice to that affect in writing
