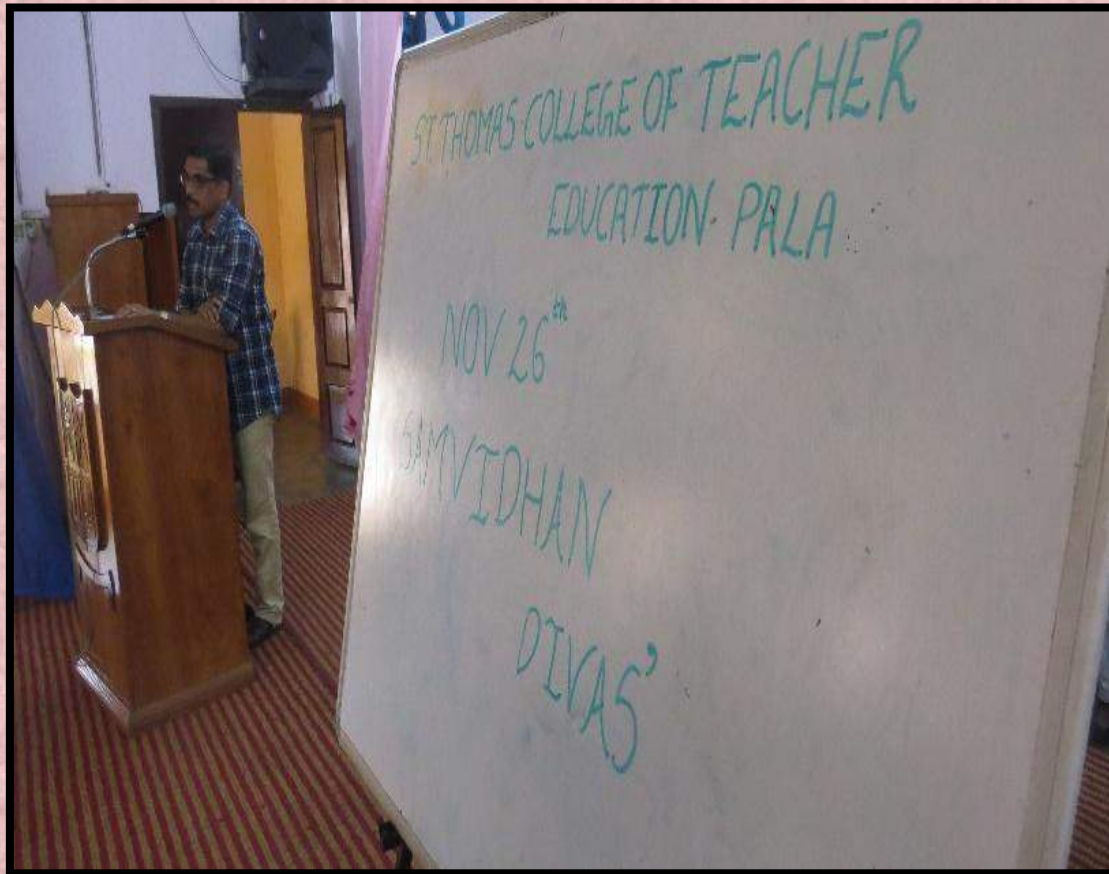

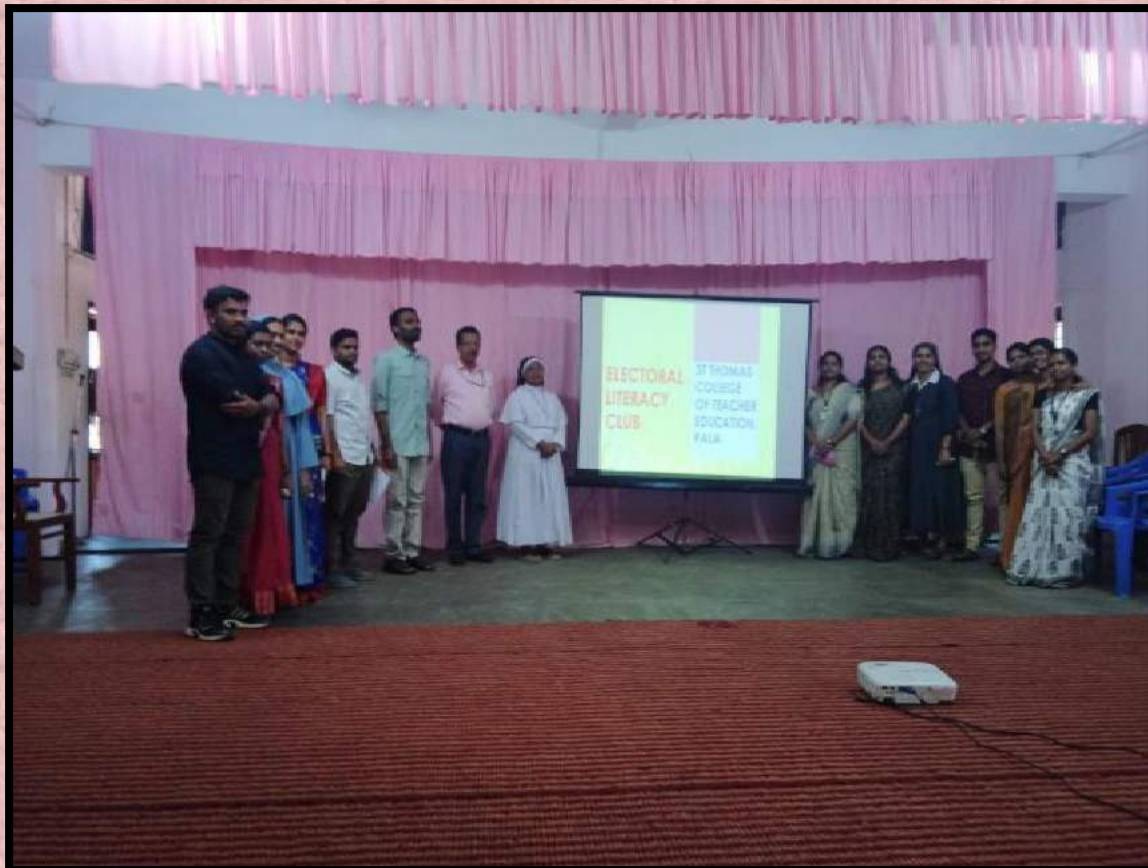




## **The National Voters' Day Celebration, 4 February 2020**
