HISTORY

St. Thomas College of Teacher Education, Pala was established in 1957 as one of the pioneer institutions in the field of teacher education. The Institution was accredited with 4 star level by NAAC in 2000. It is the first teacher education institution to be reaccredited with A+ grade by NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council 2007) with an institutional score of 92 in the state of Kerala. Again in 2014, we successfully attained A grade in the NAAC accreditation.

The Institution was conferred minority status by National Commission for minority Educational Institution 2010 Our college is quite uncompromising in providing the students with the best amenities. Our growth towards academic excellence is due to the commitment and concrete enterprise of our teachers and administrative staff. Many of our teachers are frequently invited for giving lectures and have served as resource persons for many academic and community oriented programmes.

The college was started to meet a precise need, ie, to train teachers for the secondary & Higher Secondary schools in our country. This idea was conceived and was made into reality by the then Bishop of the diocese of Palai, His Excellency Rt. Rev. Dr. Sebastian Vayalil, the founder & first patron of our institution. From 1981 to 2004 His Excellency Rt. Rev. Dr. Joseph Pallickaparampil was our patron. His Excellency Rt. Rev. Dr. Joseph Kallarangattu is our present patron. His Excellency Mar Jacob Muricken is the Present manager of the college. The college offers B.Ed., M.Ed. and Elementary Teacher Training courses.

This institution is owned and run by the Catholic Diocese of Palai, and is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam.

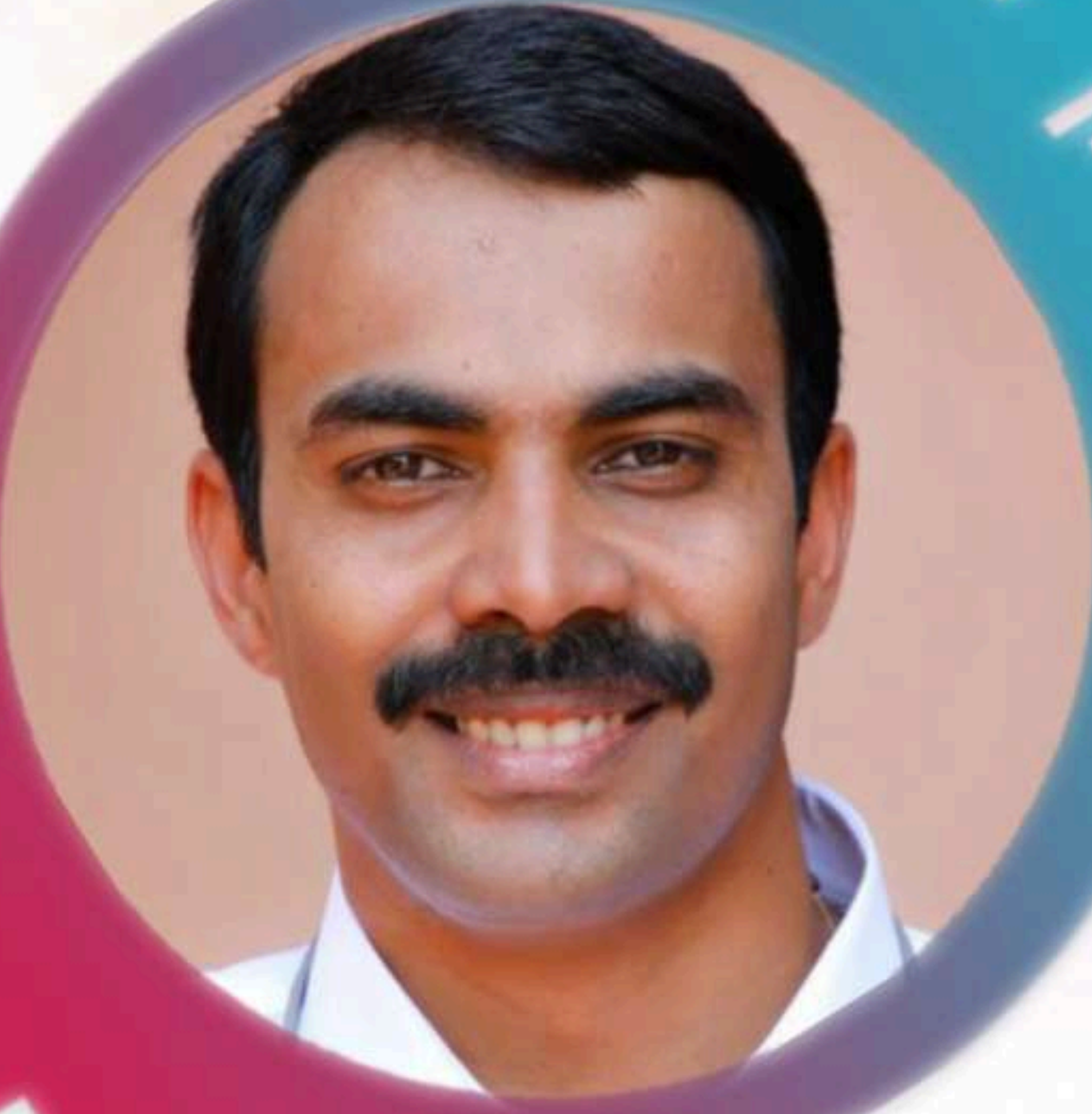

Vice Principal's Message

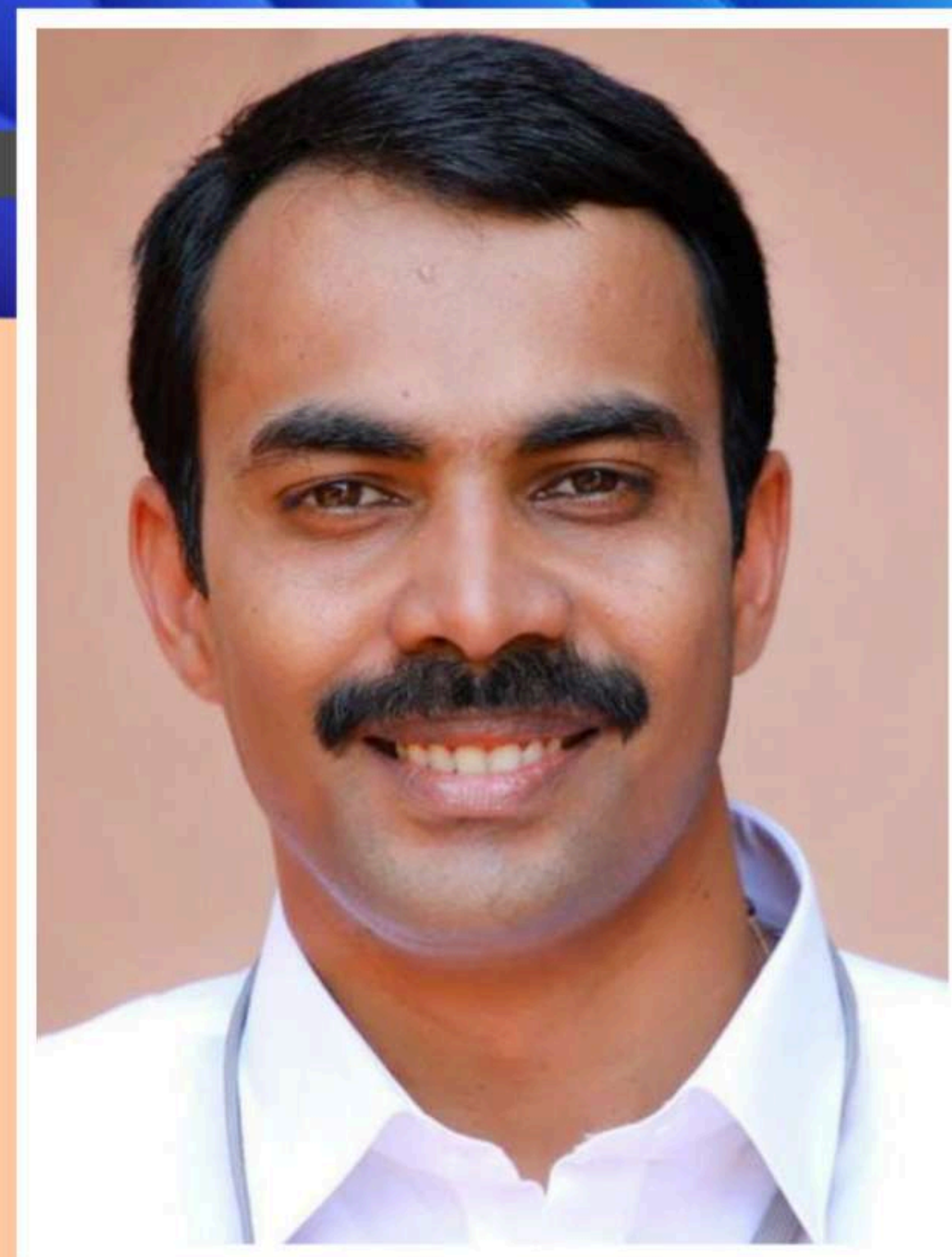

REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY - 1)

As per the requirements of the B.Ed. curriculum, the second-year students of St. Thomas College of Teacher Education, Pala conducted one of their two prescribed extension activities at Arunapuram Government LP School on 1/4/2022, which was named "Nirakoot 2022 - Adding colours to life". As part of the programme three activities were planned, they were as follows: to paint pictures on the school walls, clean the school premises, and to create a vegetable garden in the school grounds.

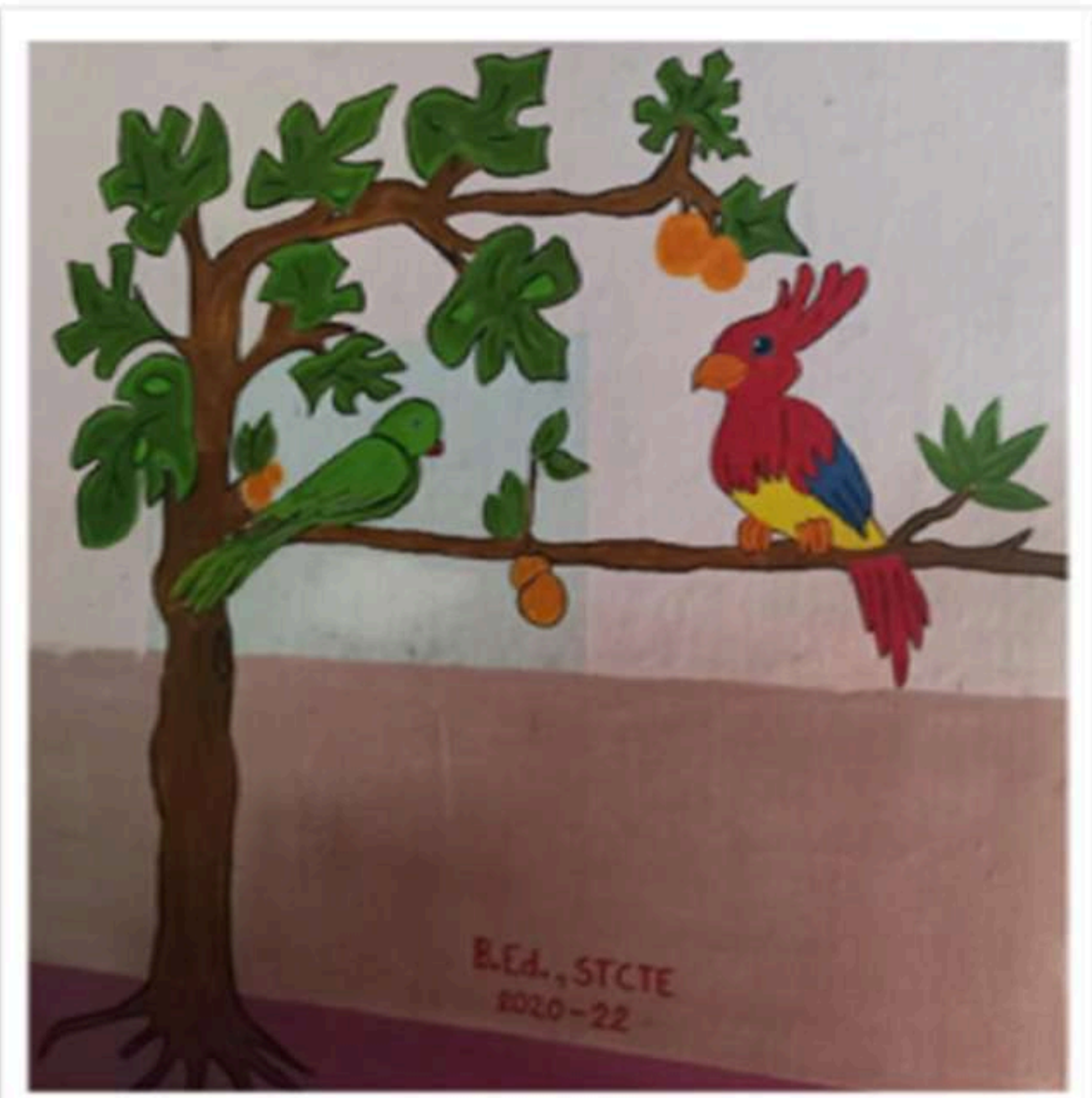
The programme began with a general assembly at nine o'clock in the morning, all the students were present at the school before nine. The staff coordinator, Dr. Alex George and the student coordinator Sojo John gave the necessary instructions, which were duly followed. The student teachers painted pictures and the letters of the Malayalam alphabet on the walls of the school, cleaned the school premises, and planted plants and vegetables in the school grounds. All these activities were conducted with the object of nurturing social commitment in the student teachers and to create a learning environment which favours the mental enjoyment of children. The lunch and refreshments were prepared by the student teachers themselves. From time-to-time water and refreshments were provided to the students to ensure the smooth conduct of the programme. At 12:15 p.m all the activities were completed and everyone gathered in the school hall for the valedictory function.



The meeting was presided over by Shri. Shibu Mon George, Headmaster, Arunapuram Government LP School. Rev. Fr. Dr. Thomas Moolayil delivered the keynote address. Dr. T.C Thankachan, the Principal of STCTE, Pala honoured Rev. Fr. Dr. Thomas Moolayil in the meeting for his noble efforts in promoting the Malayalam language. The toys that the student teachers have sponsored were handed over to the headmaster of the school, by the principal in the meeting. College Vice Principal Dr. Beenamma Mathew; IQAC Coordinator, Lavina Dominic; Teacher in Charge, Dr. Alex George; Student Coordinators Mr. Sojo John and Ms. Reshma Raju were the other members of the dais. After the meeting, lunch followed. Fr. Thomas Moolayil observed and evaluated the students' works. There was a group photo session after lunch. At 2.45 pm we all took leave from the school with great satisfaction, happiness and a lot of good memories.

Five committees were selected for the successful management of the extension activity. The committees were: Food committee, cleaning committee, Art work committee, Finance committee, and Documentation committee. All 50 students were a part of at least one of these committees. Each student contributed 200 rupees for the expenses of the programme.

REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY - 2)

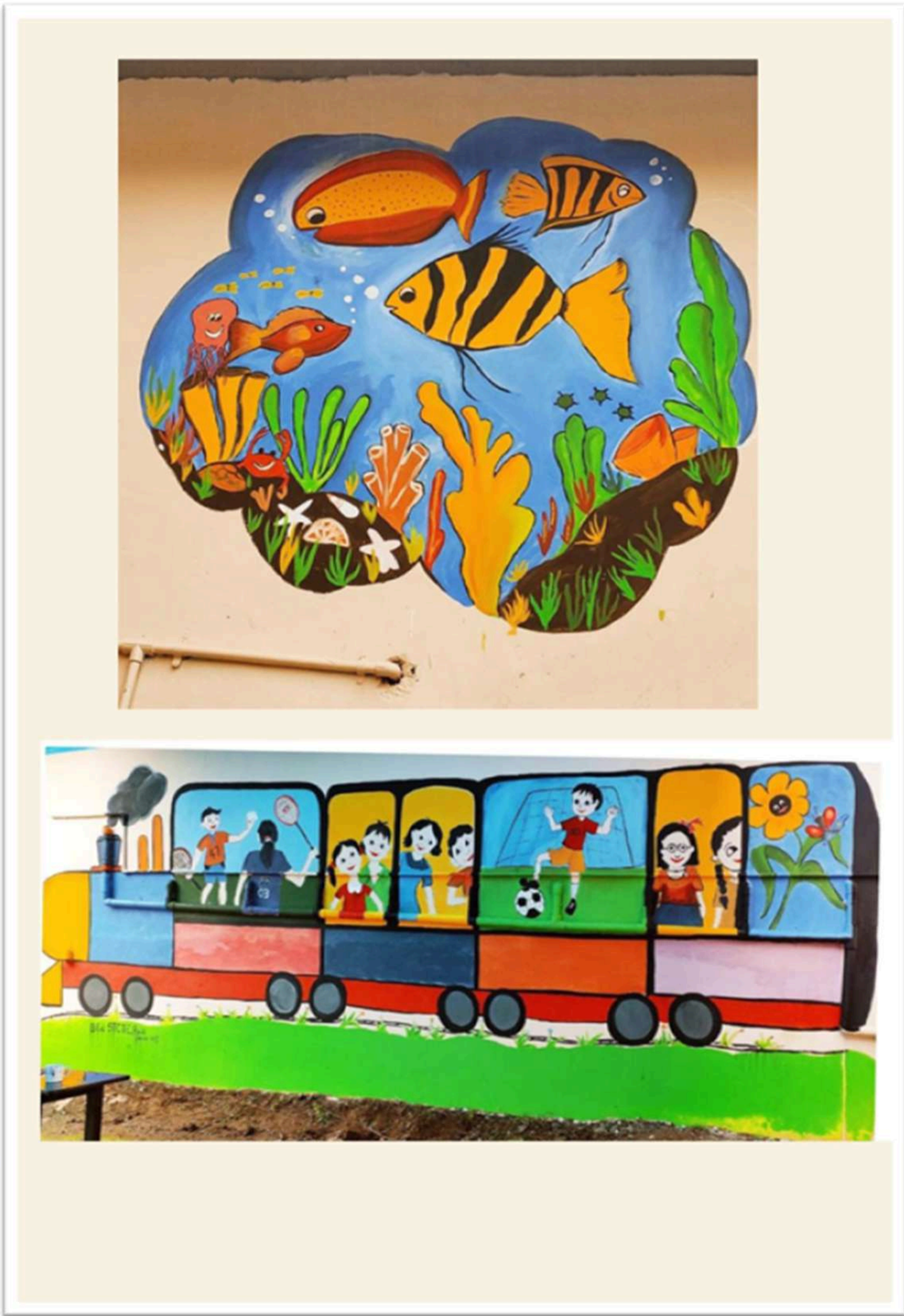

REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY- 3)

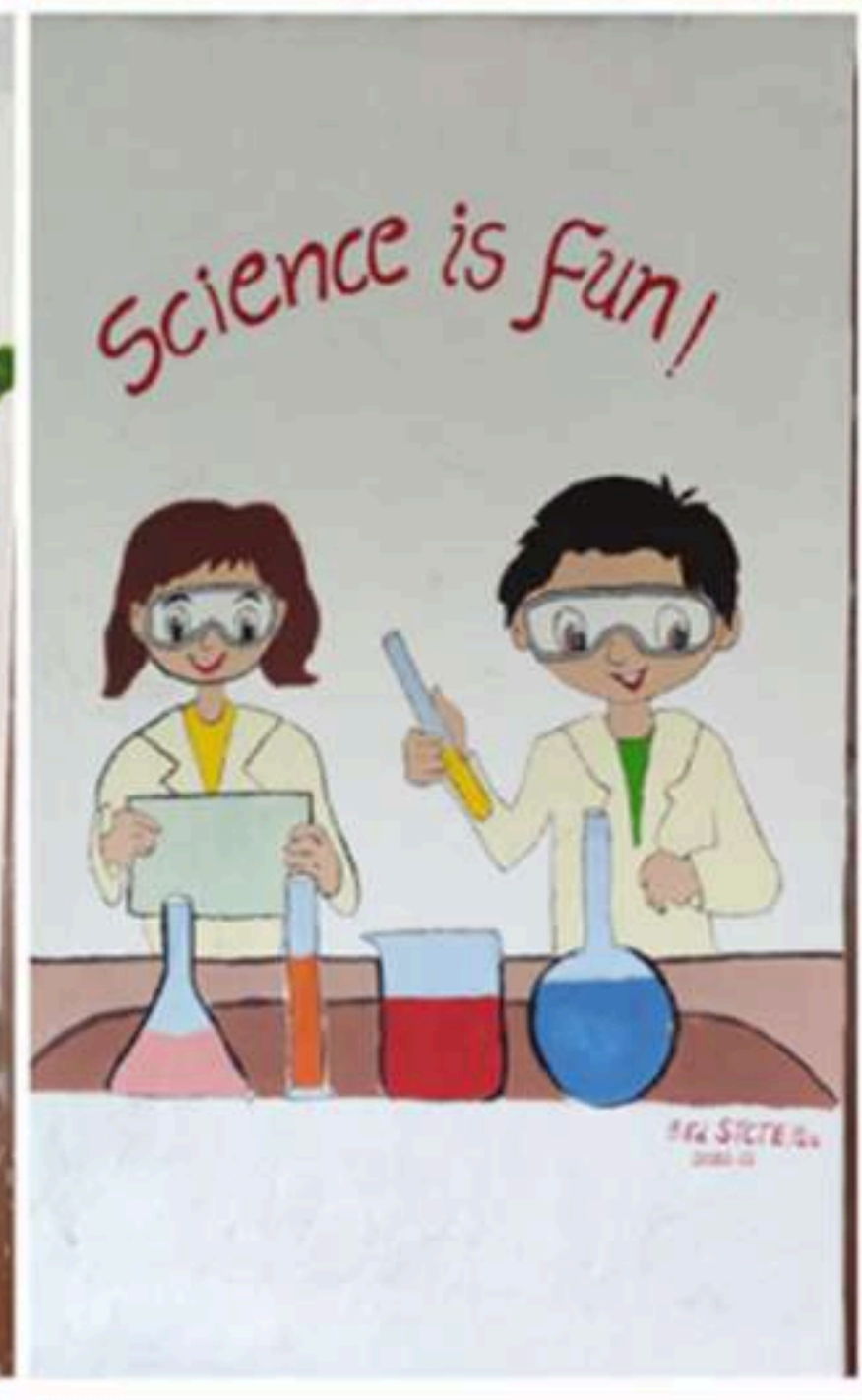
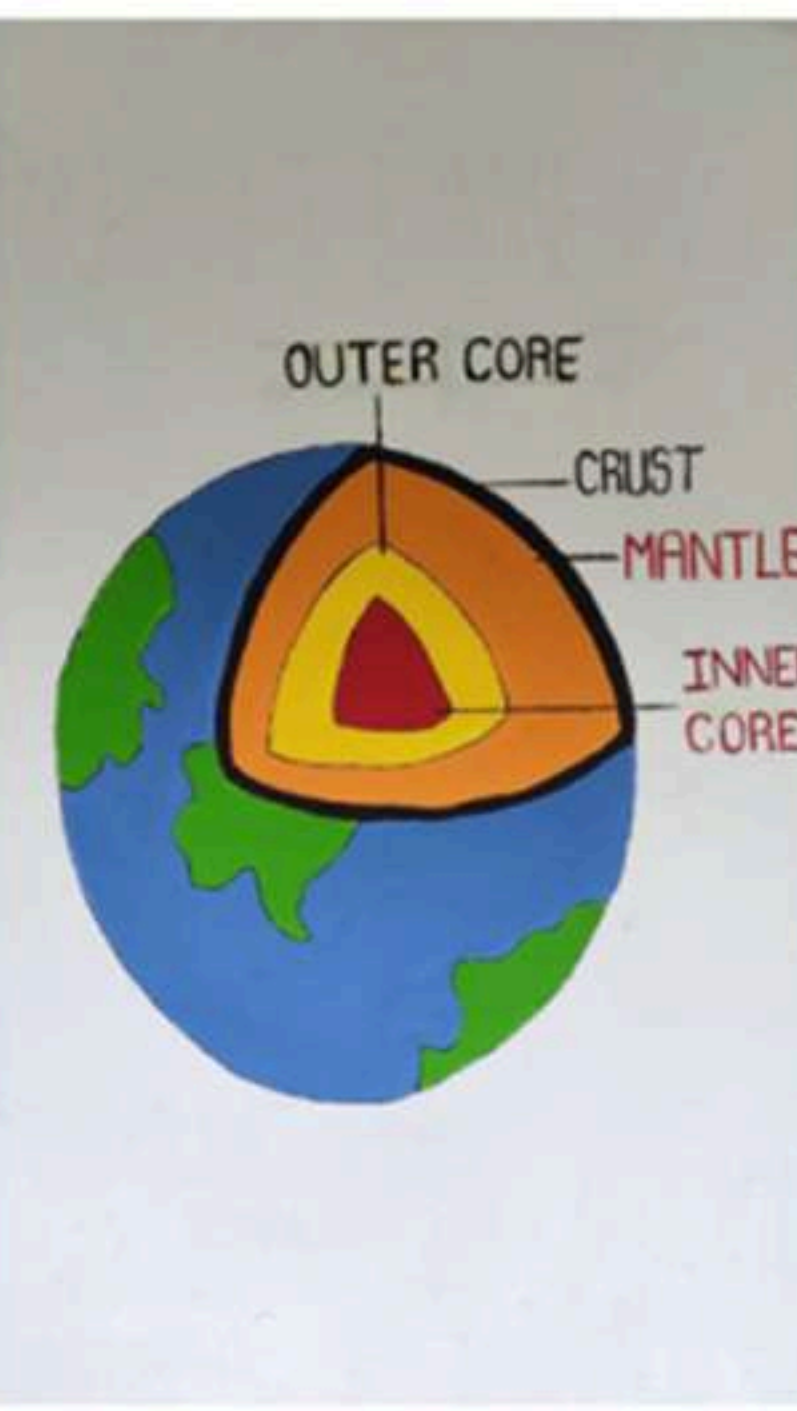

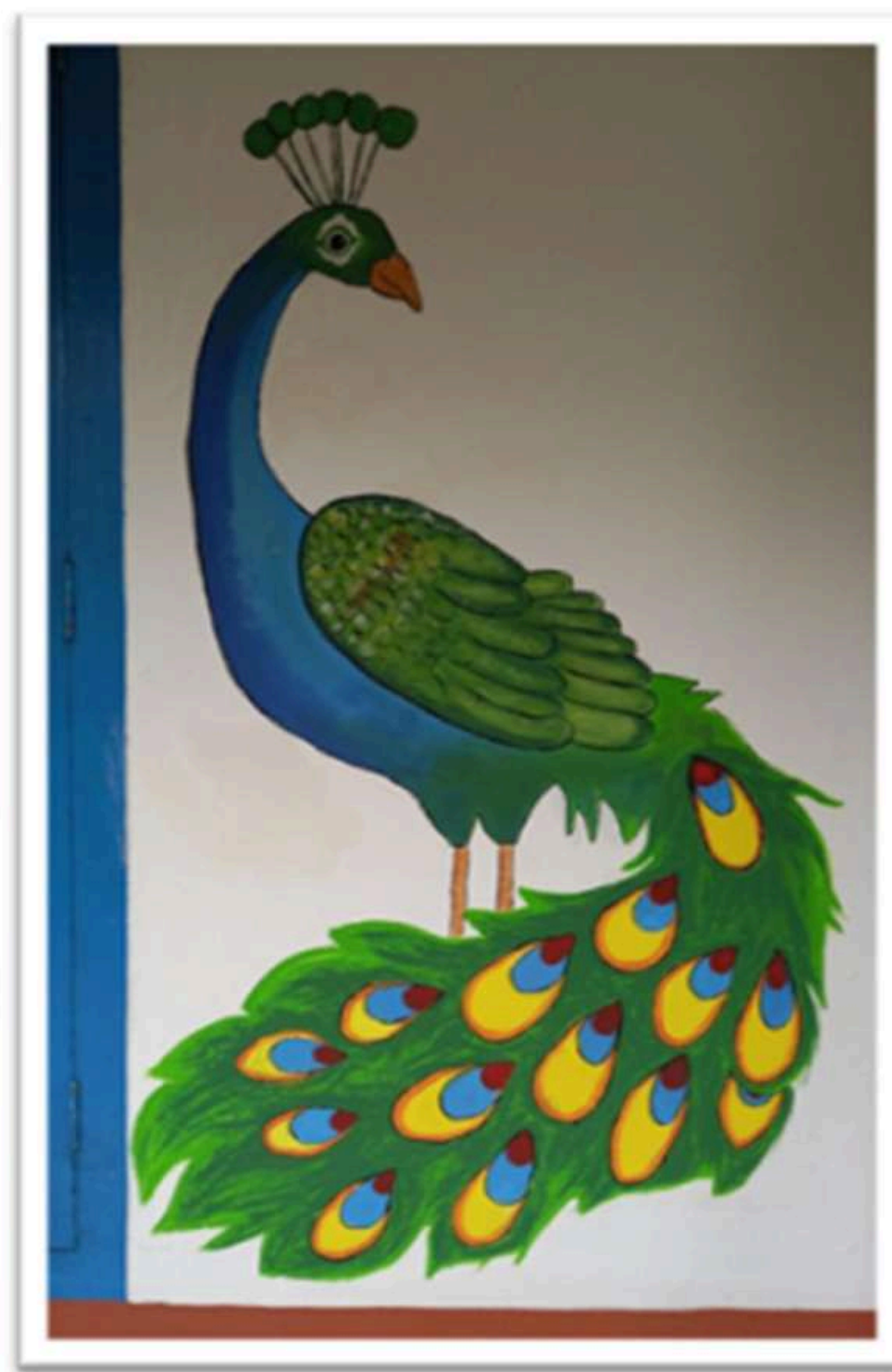
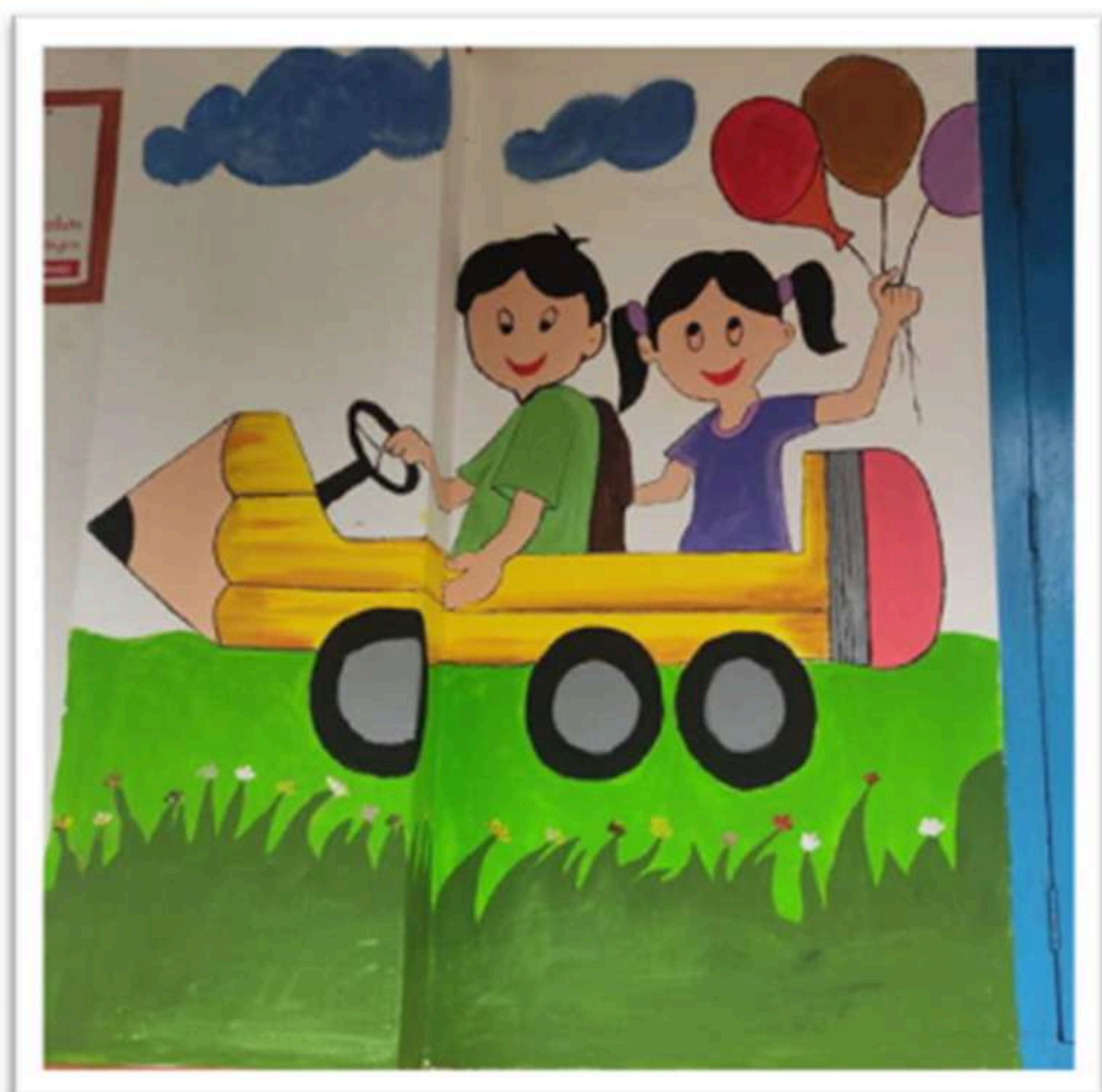
REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY-4)

REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY-5)

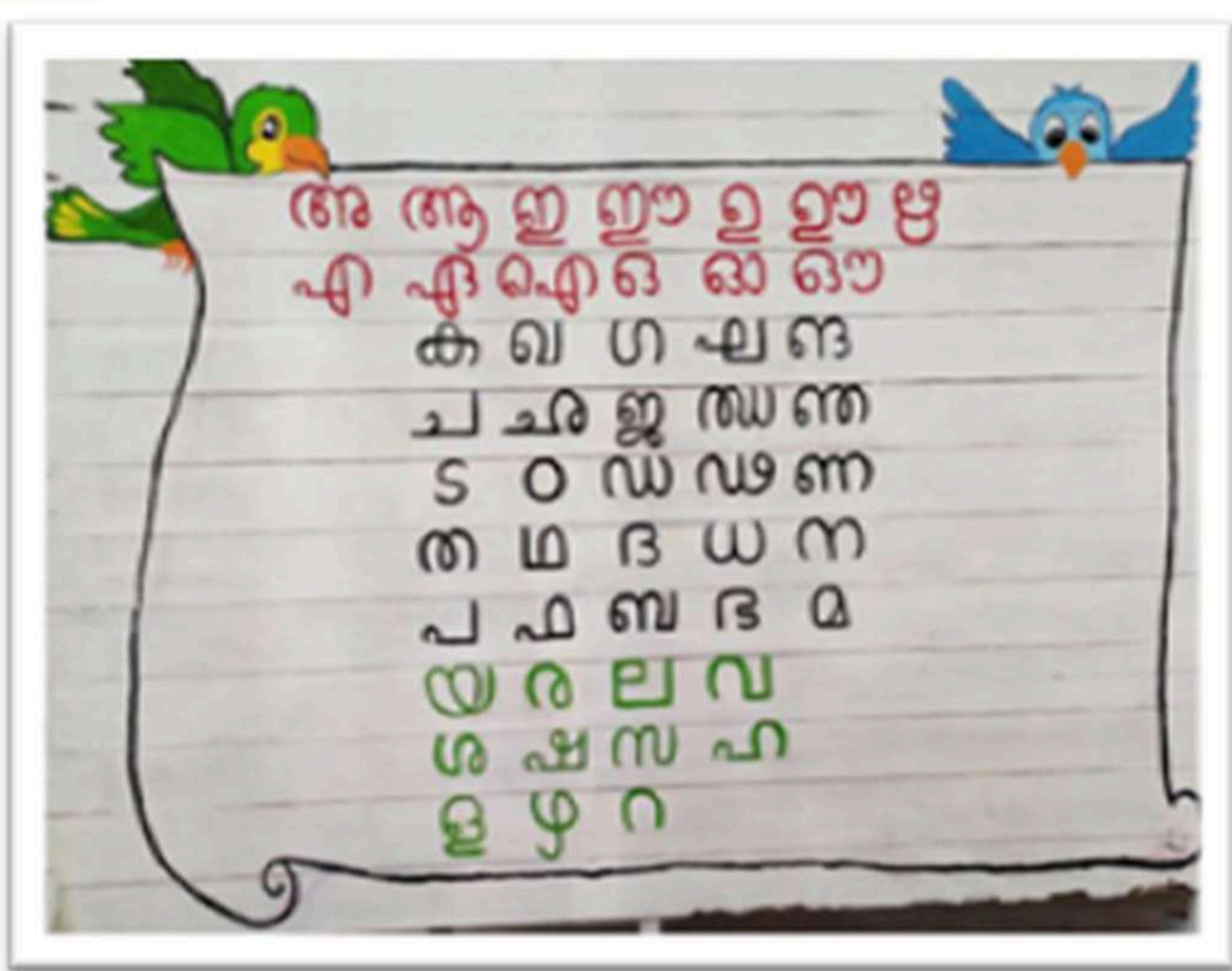

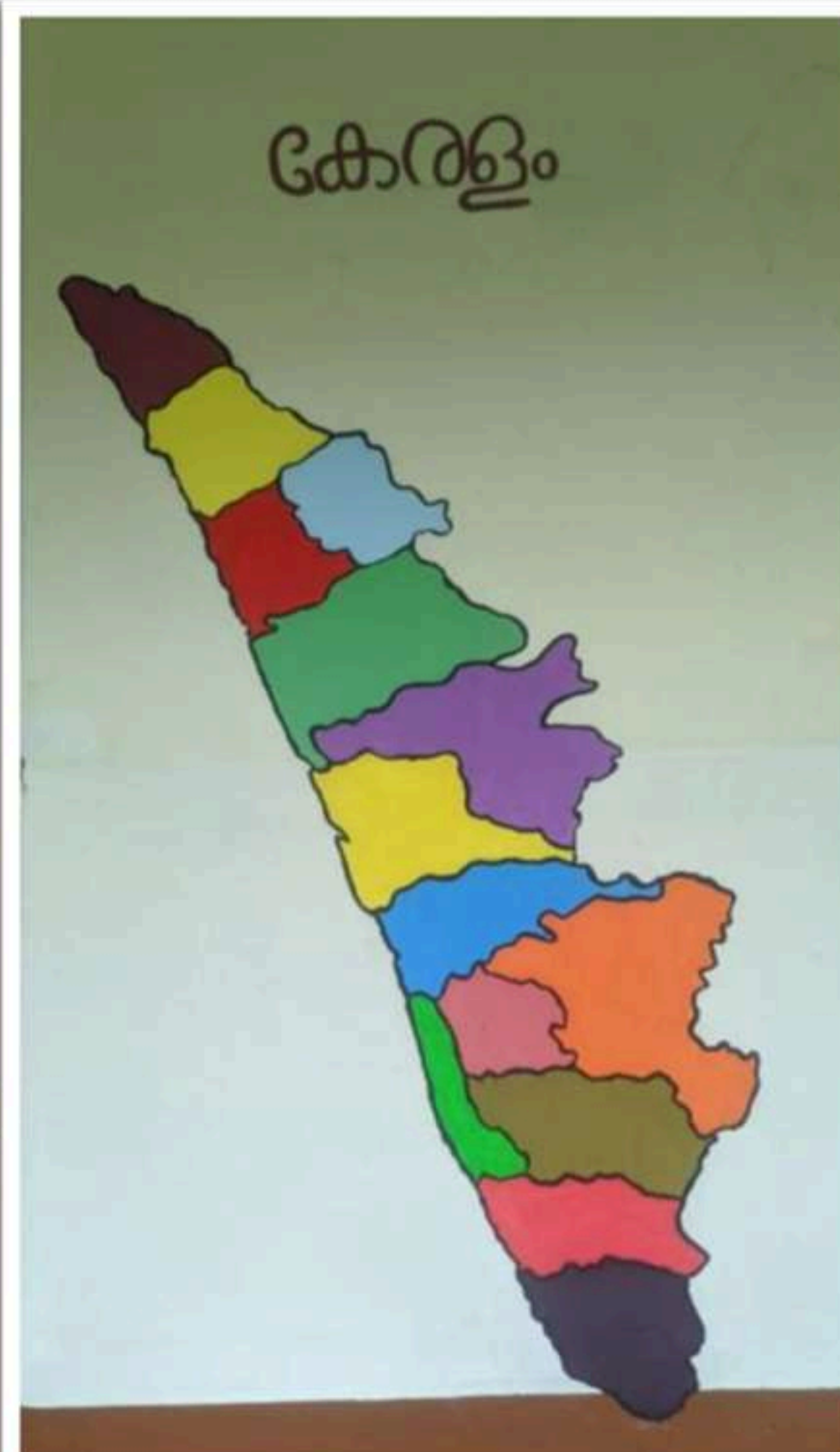
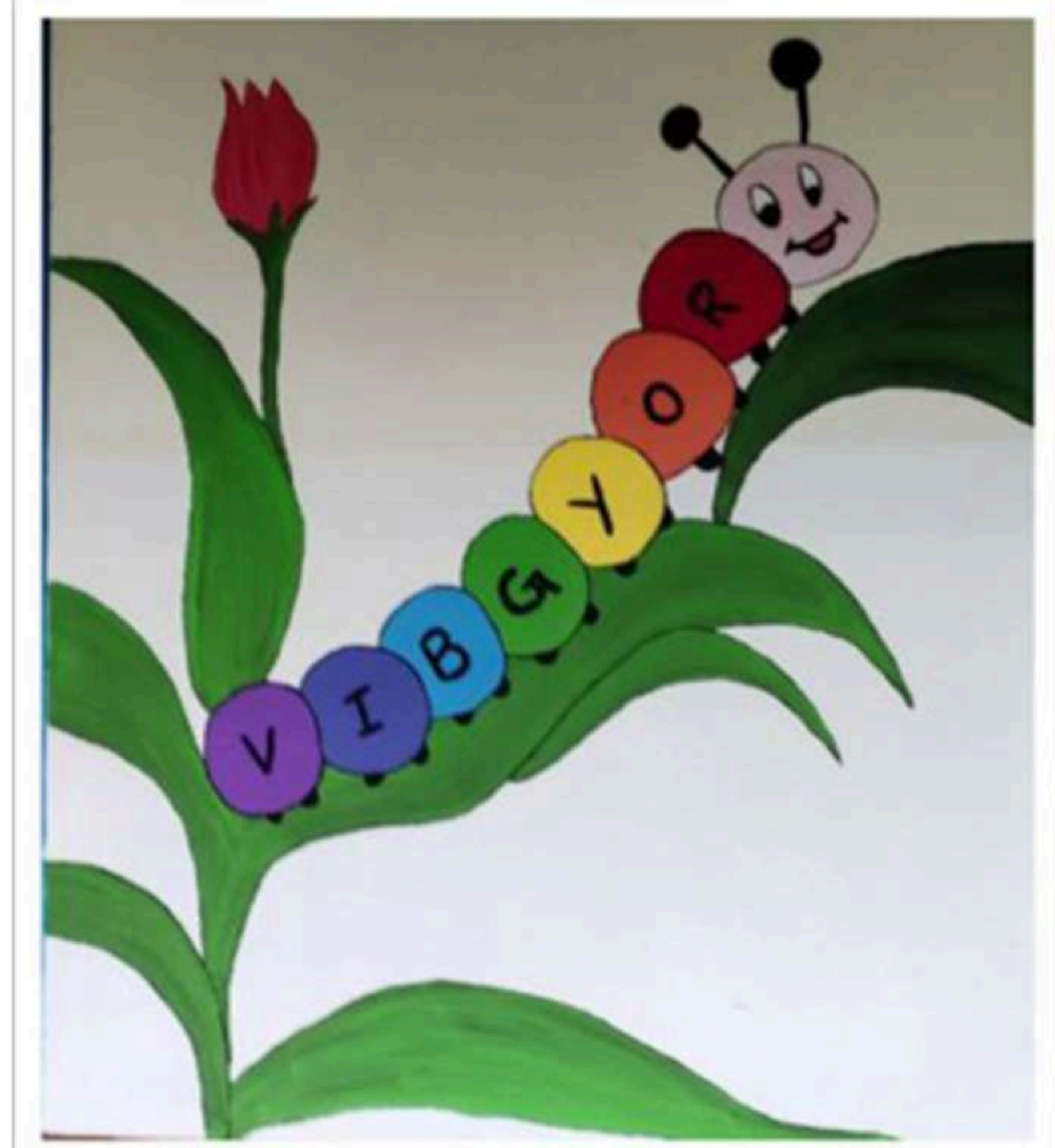
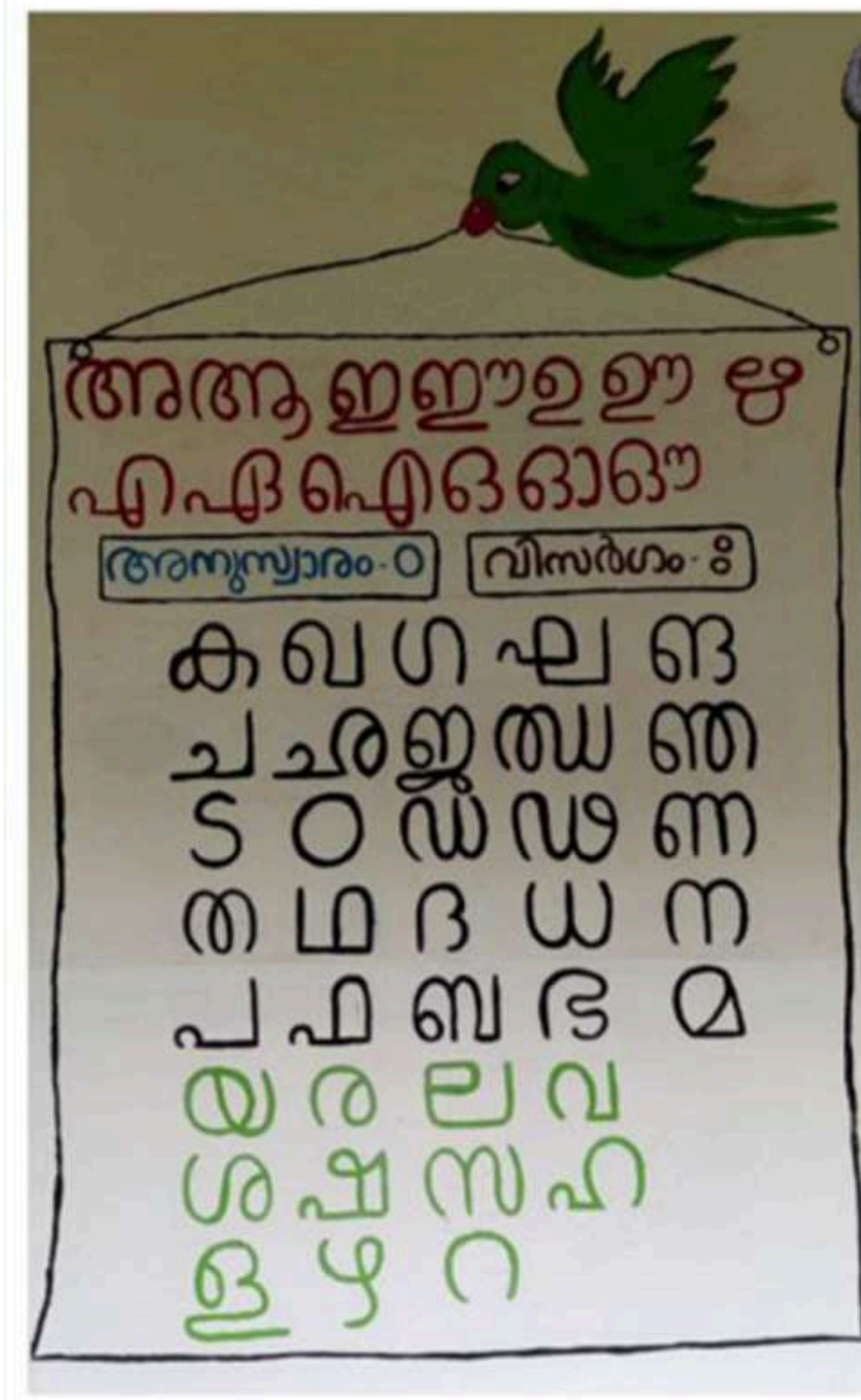
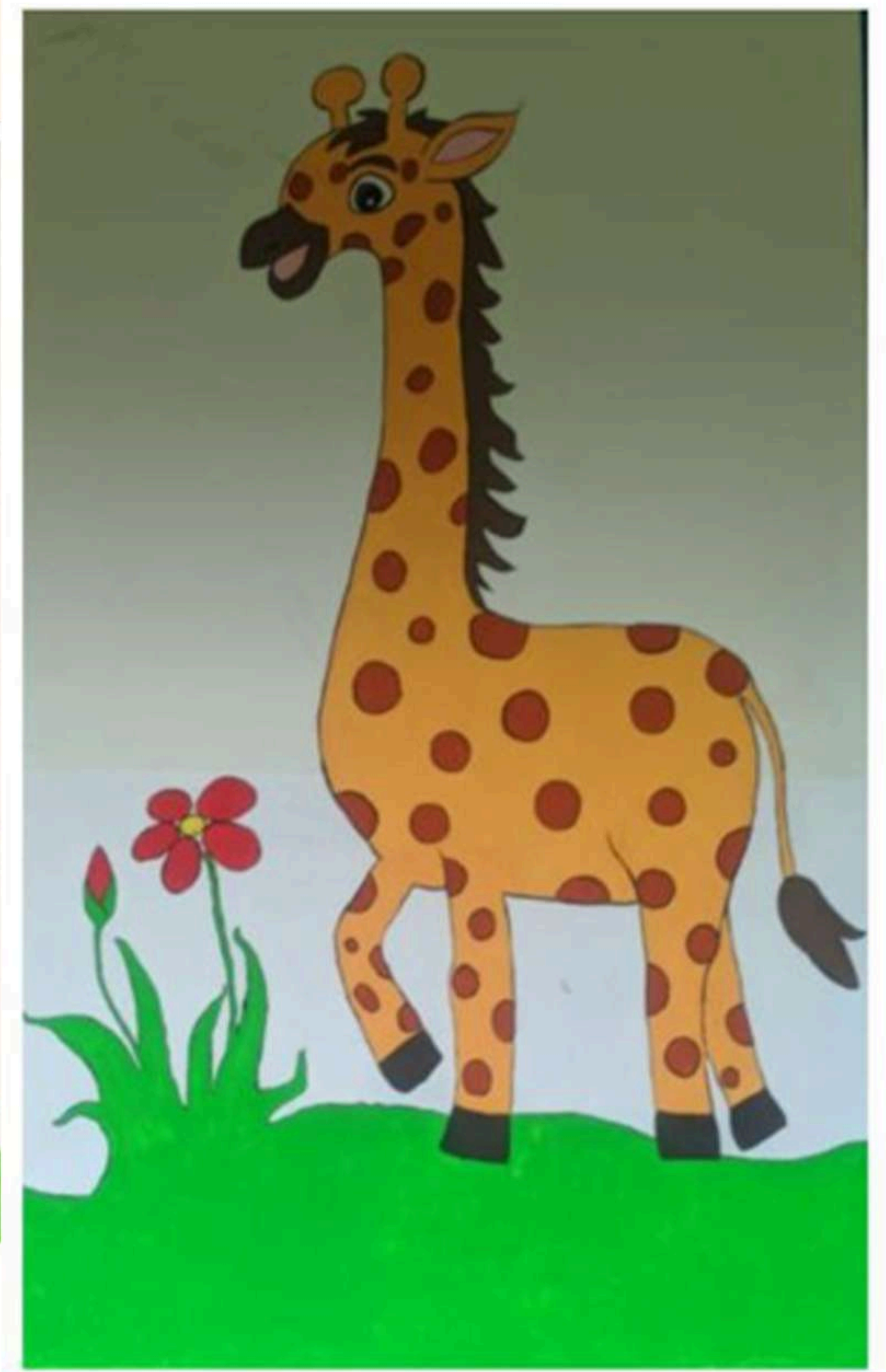
REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY - 6)

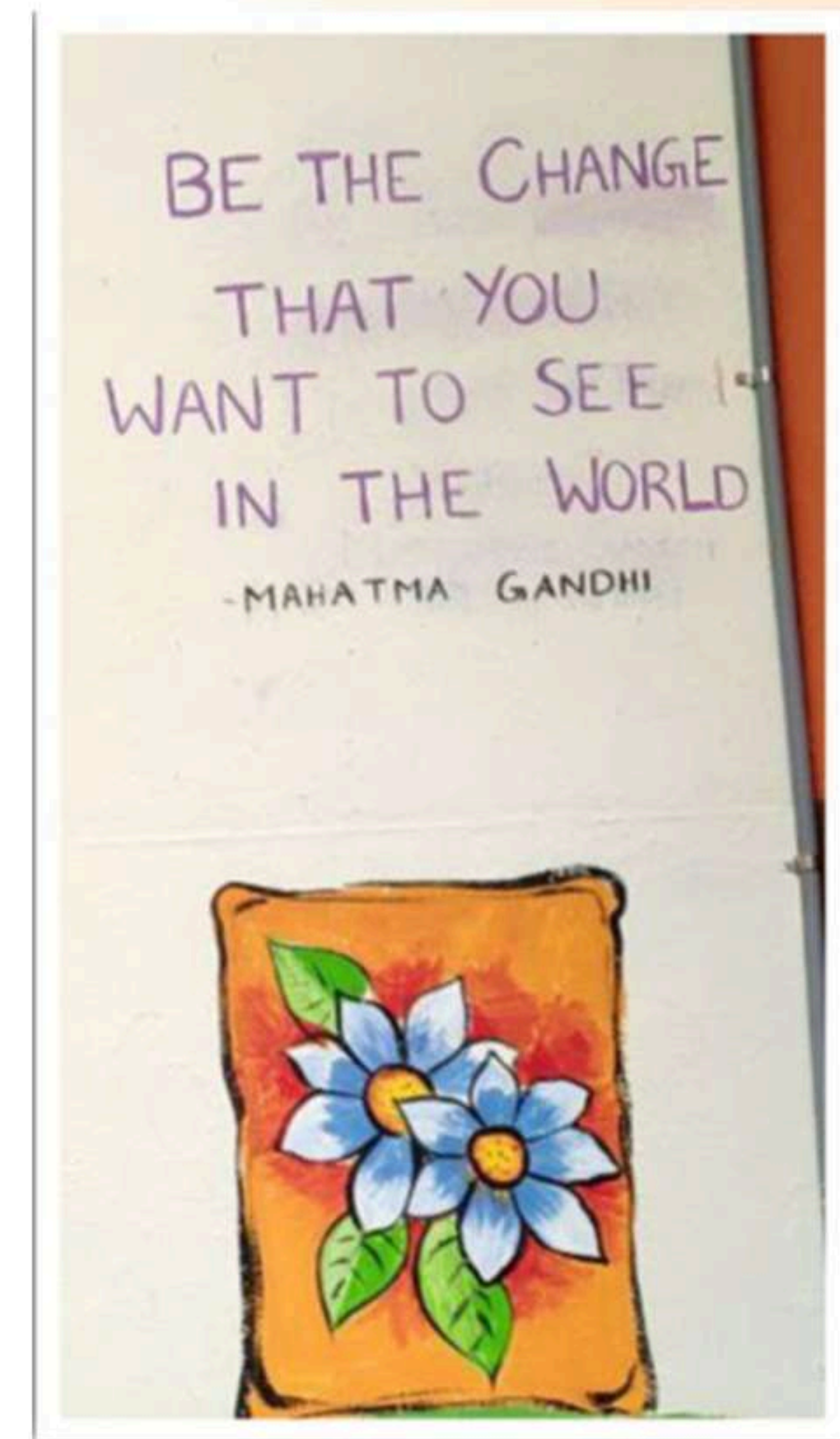

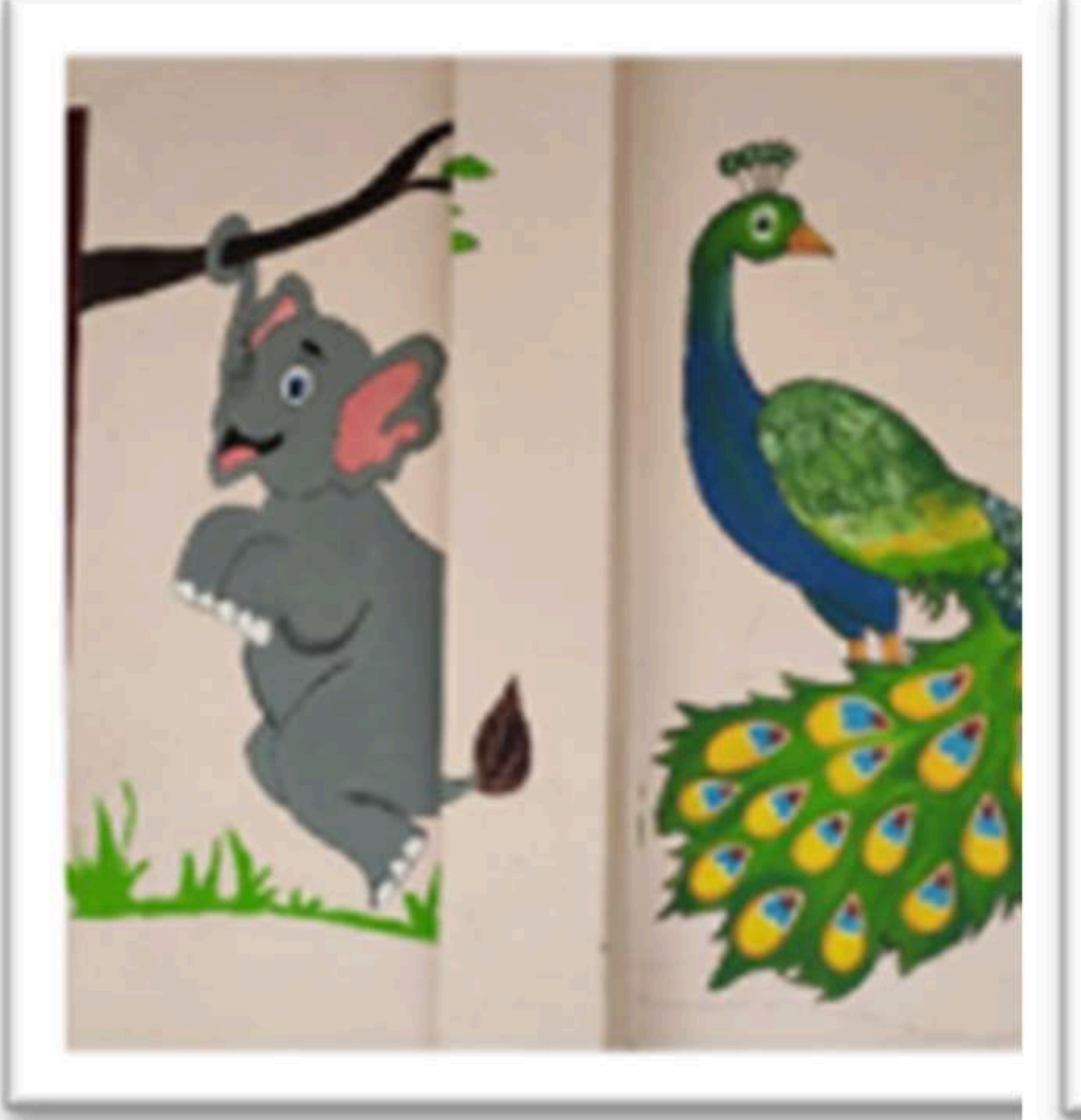
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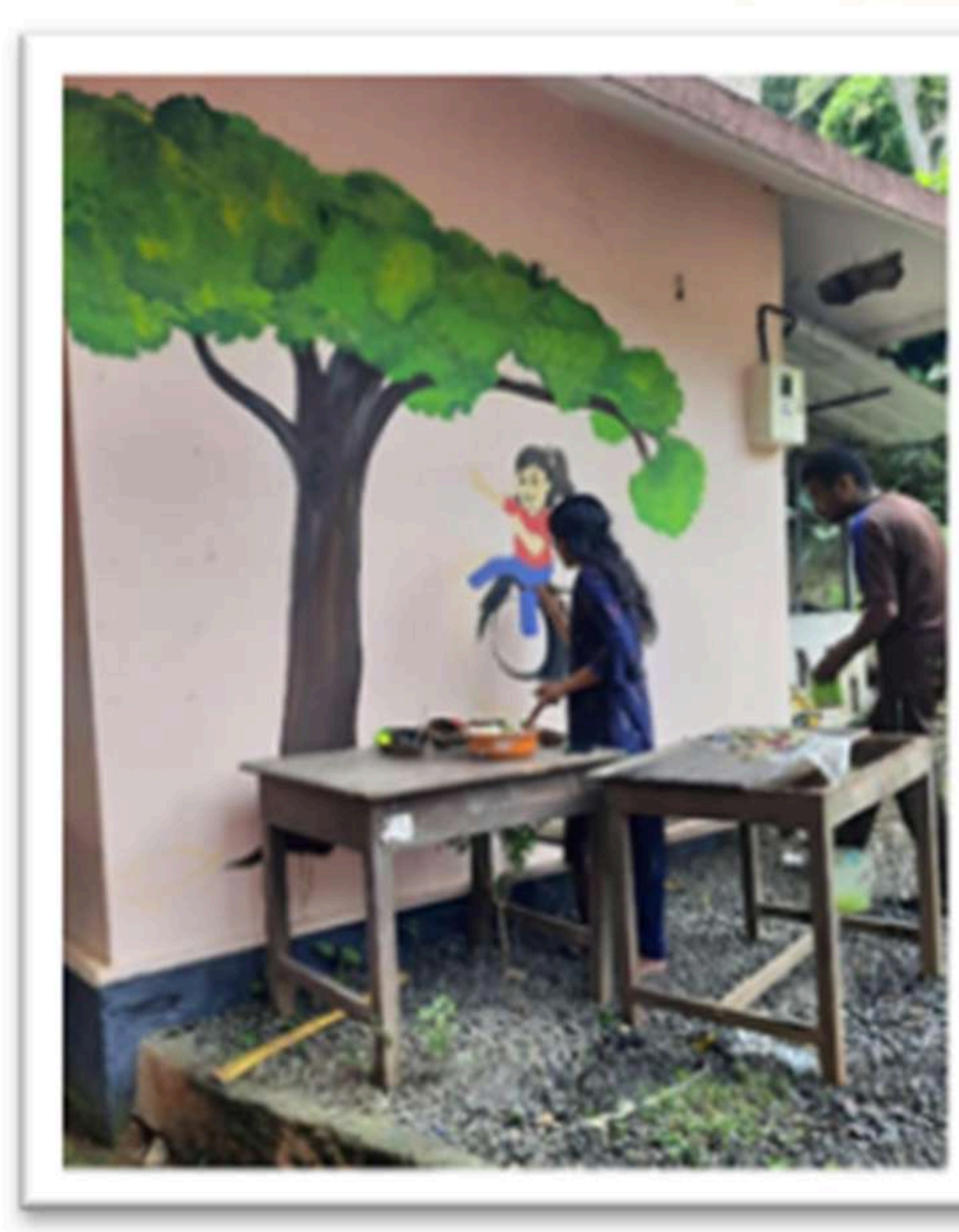
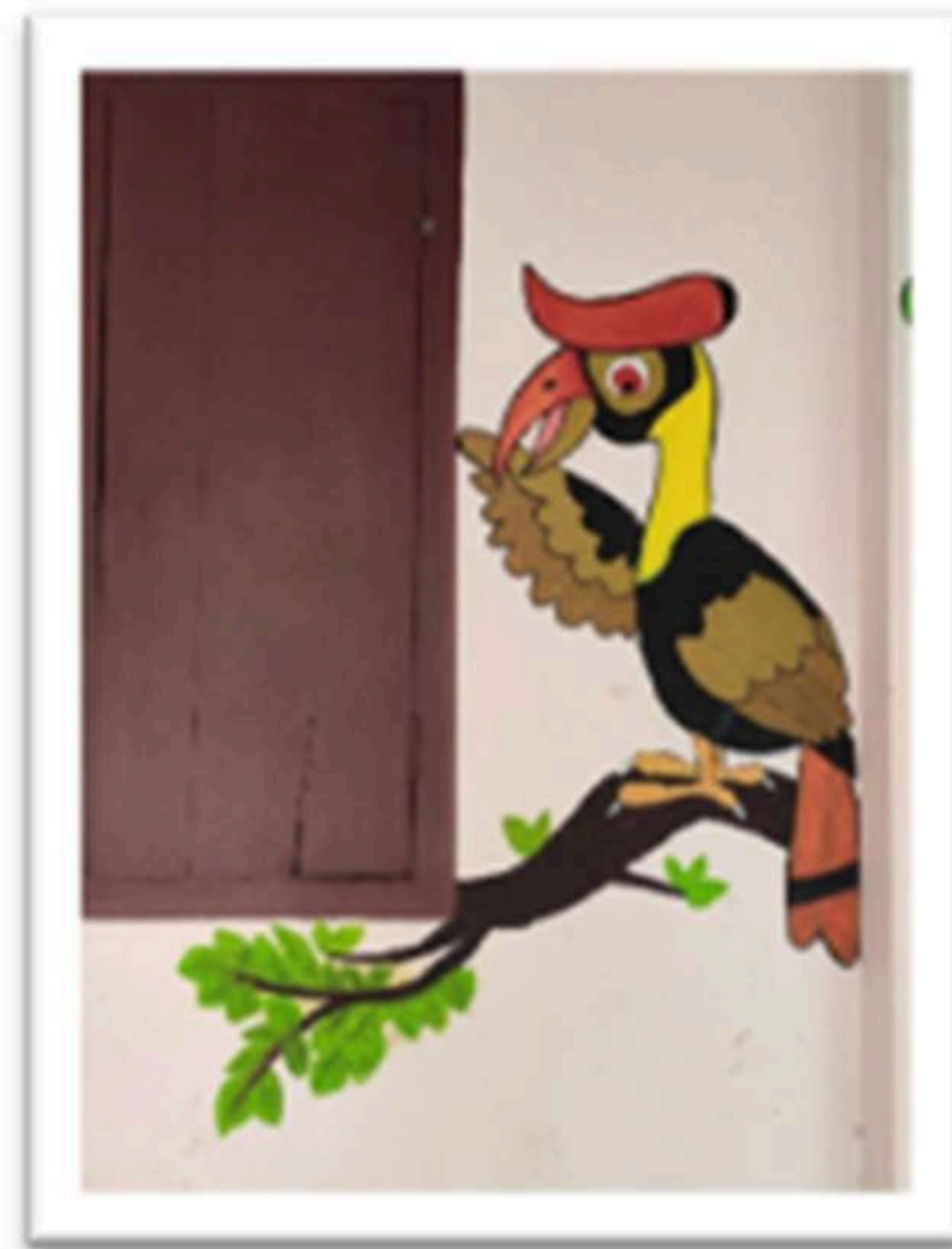


REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY-9)

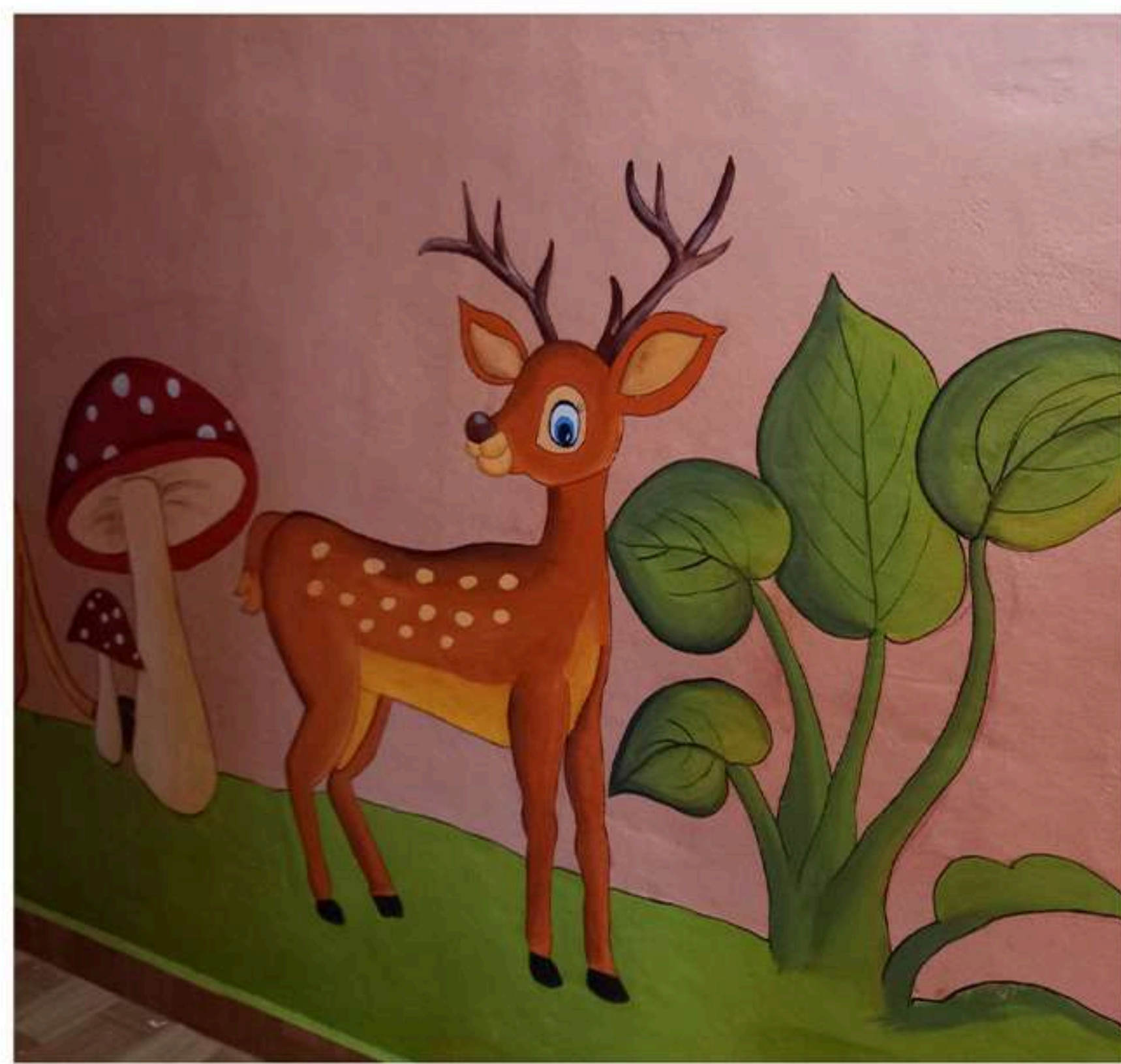


REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY- 12)

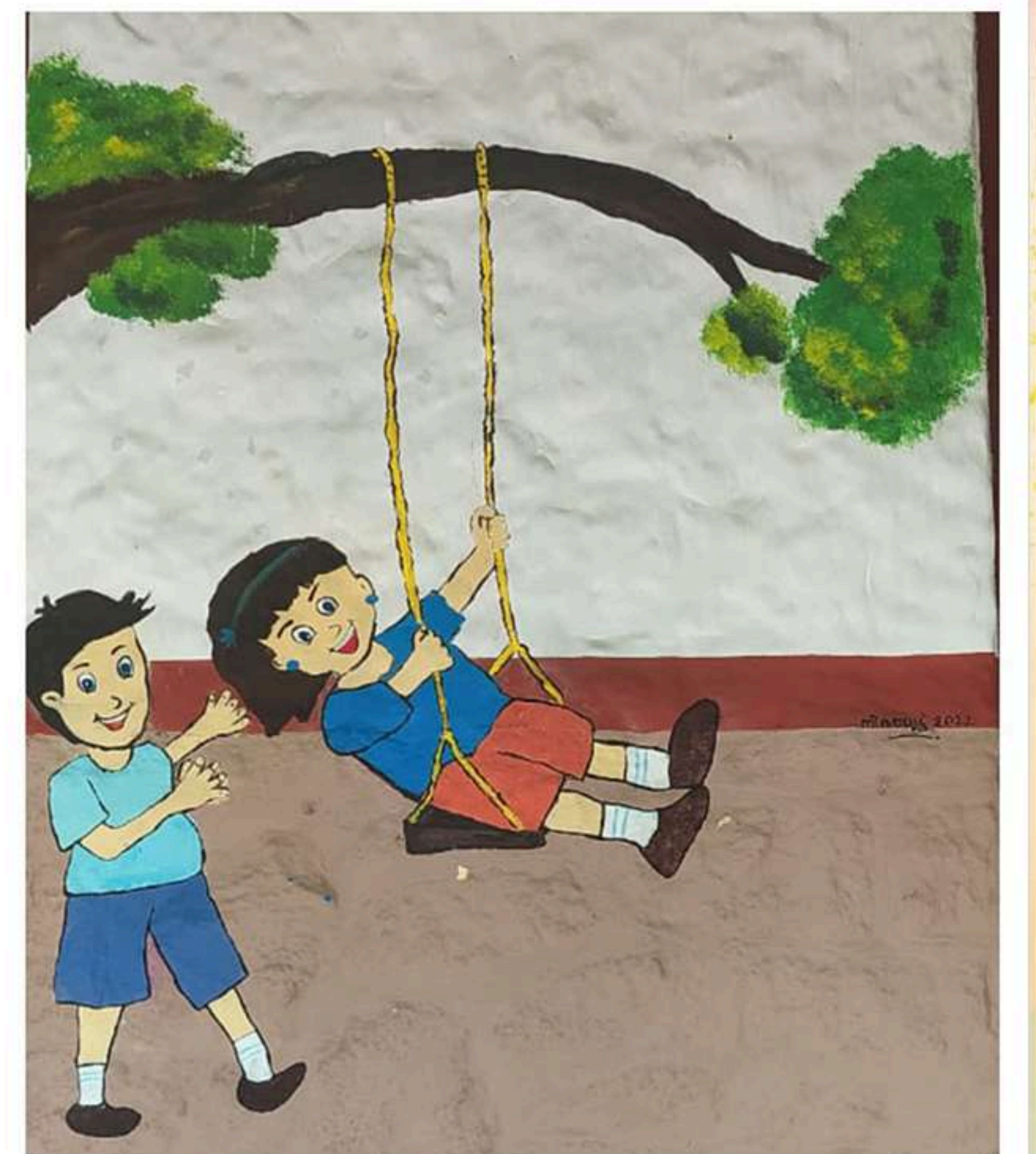
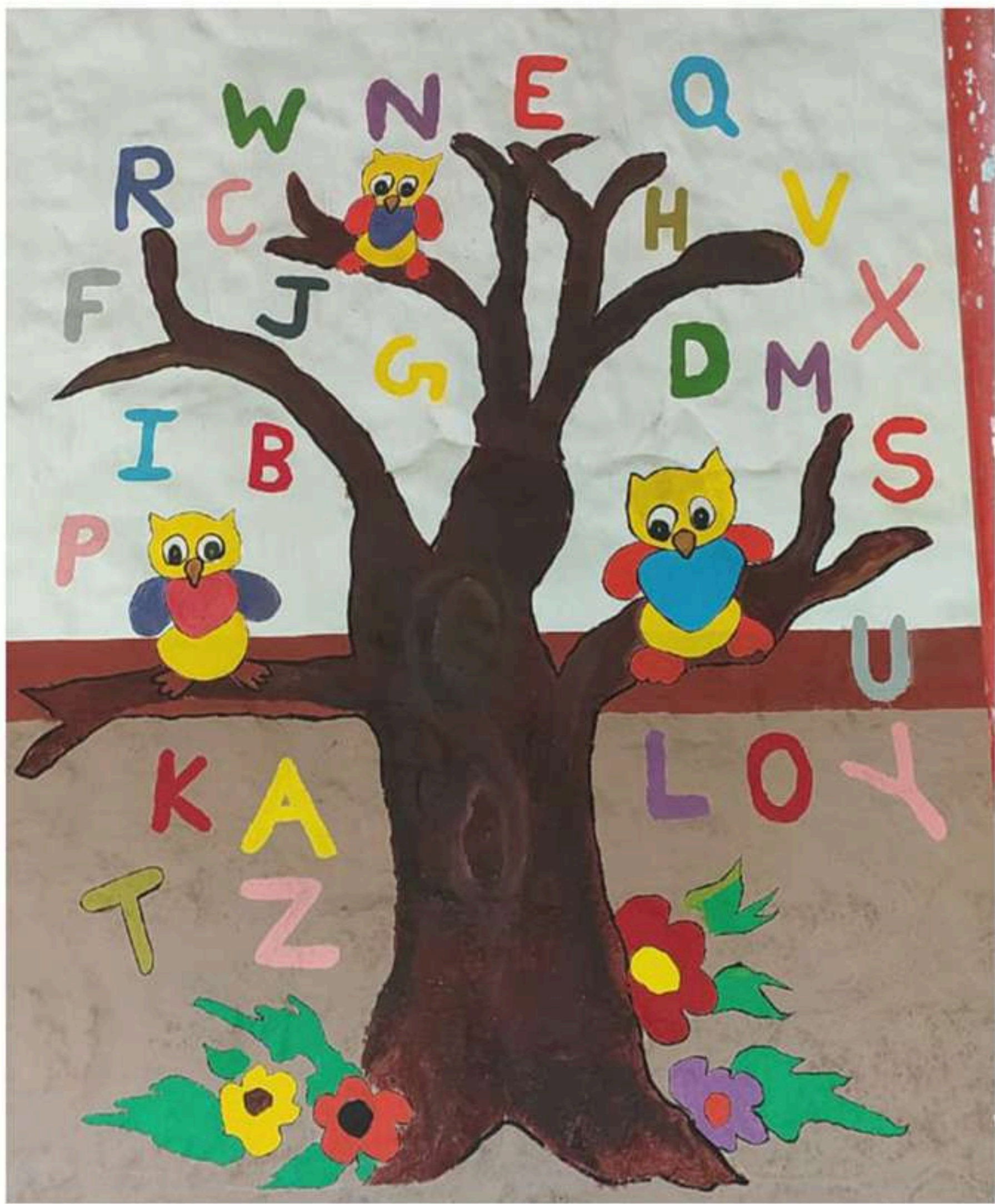
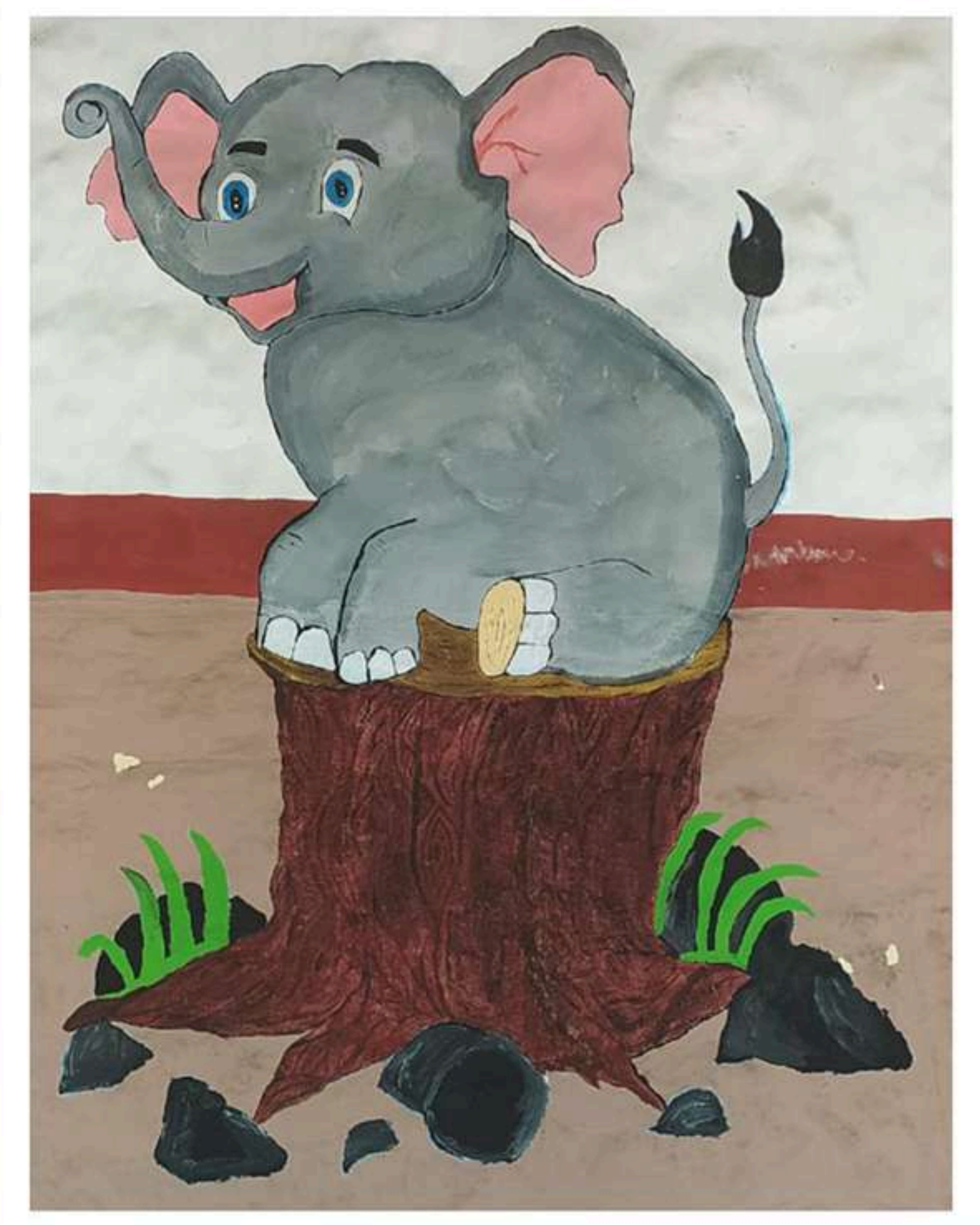
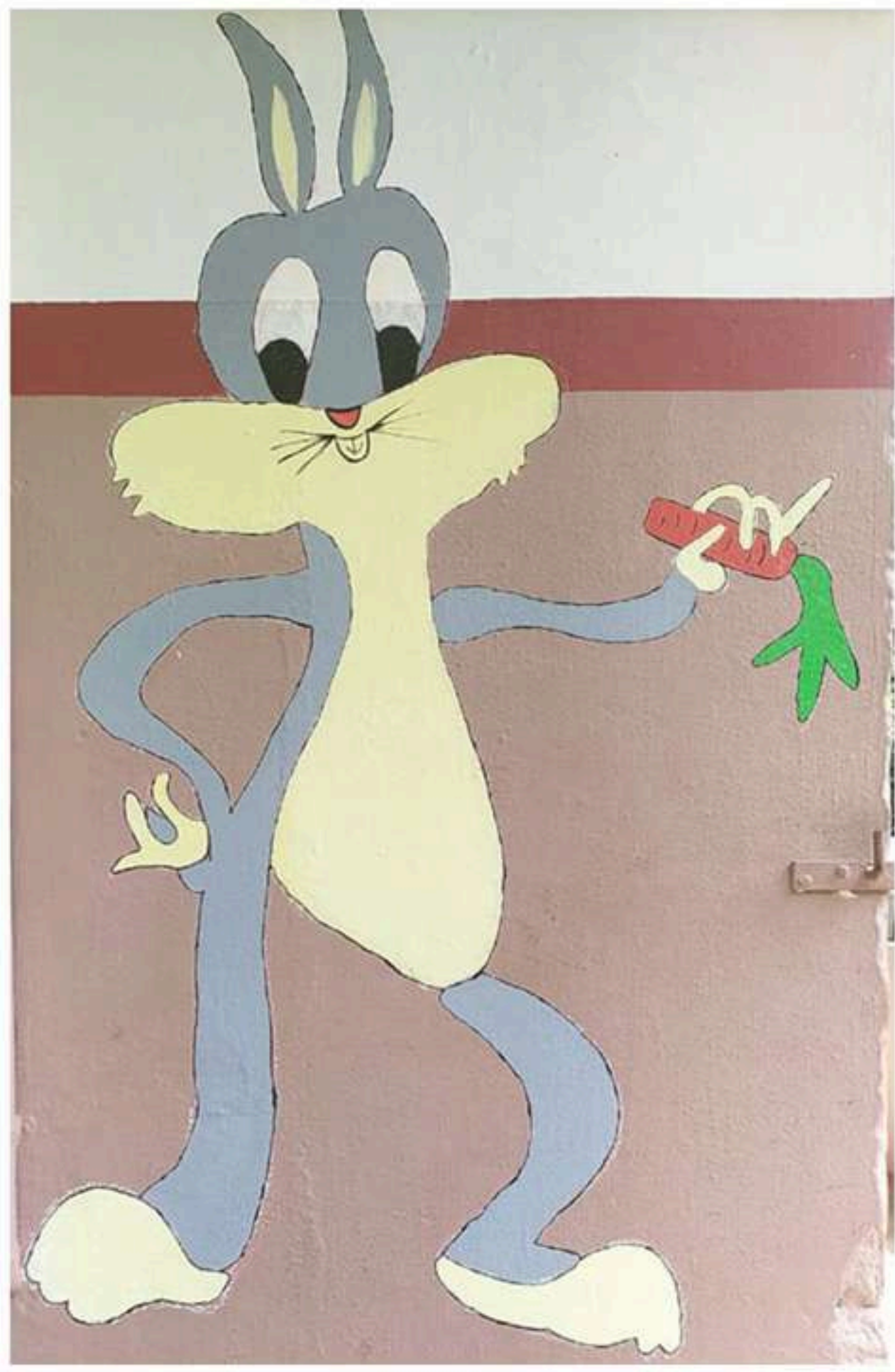
REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY- 13)

REPORT - NIRAKOOT (DAY - 14)

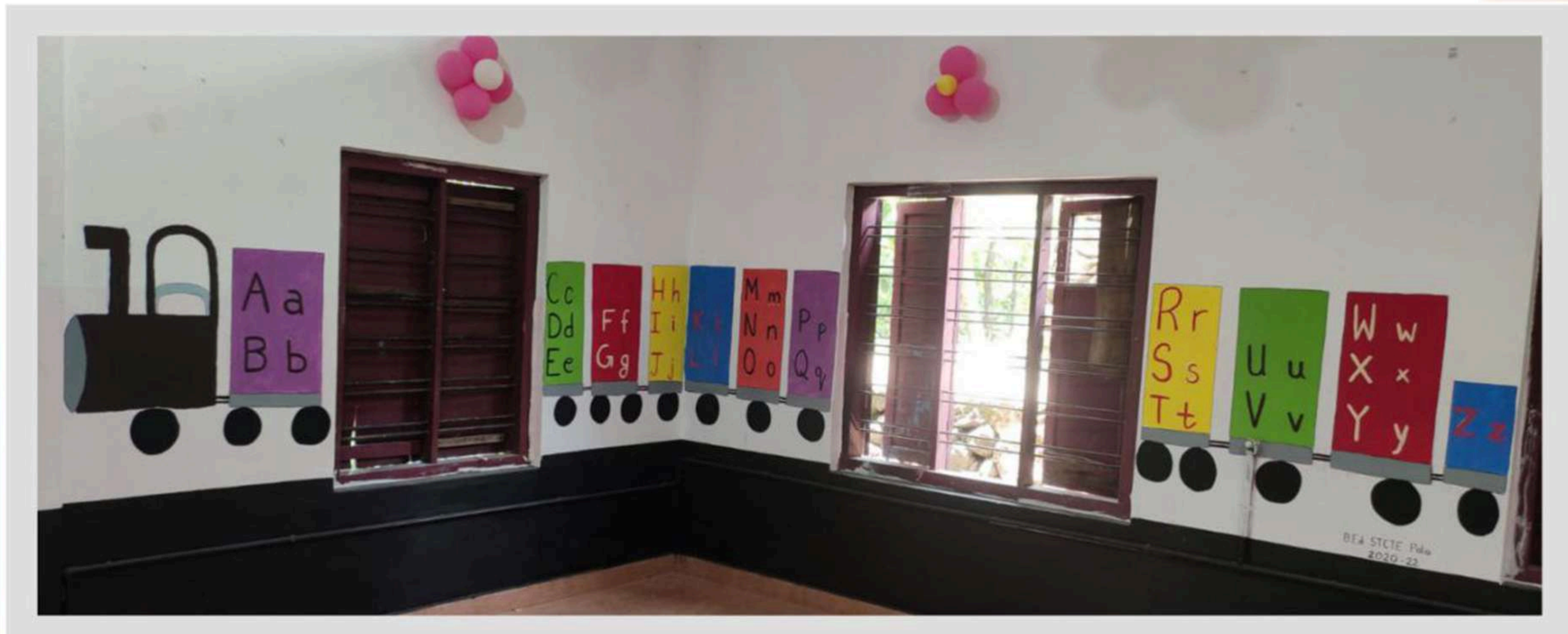
